IN EXCHANGE FOR INFORMATION AND AN ADMISSION OF GUILT, STEPHEN TANTEL WAS SENTENCED TO NINE YEARS IN PRISON. SHORTLY AFTER STEPHEN ENTERED PRISON, JEANNE DIVORCED HIM.
