Constituti onal Amendments	Florida Roundtable	Yaffee talks about why he is voting no on most of the amendments. He believes that most of the Amendments that are proposed on the ballot every year are things that should be left up to the legislature. He also talks about the bundling of some of the amendments by the CRC and how that just makes things extra confusing. - 10 minutes Interview starts with Kallinger. He talks about how he got involved with the Save My Constitutional Coalition. Kallinger is a former legislature who saw how the Constitution Revision Commission (CRC) came up with the amendments this year and wanted to help start an organization to expose the corruption of the CRC. The coalition is a completely grass roots. Their goal is to abolish the CRC because of the corruption involved in the process. - 30 minutes Kallinger gives details on how the CRC came up with amendments and how they were pushed by politics and special interests.
