VARIOUS CATEGORIES

Public Affairs Program

WXMT aired "InfoTrak." This is a weekly half hour public affairs program that aired every Sunday morning between 6:00am and 6:30am. Three different issues are dealt with each week. Among the topics typically covered are: consumer matters, parenting issues, seniors and retirement, police and crime, women's issues, aging, poverty, and minority concerns. A complete listing of the topics covered in each InfoTrak program that aired during the period covered by this report is included at the back of this report.

VARIOUS CATEGORIES

Public Affairs Program

WXMT aired "Lincoln Radio Journal." This is a weekly half hour public affairs program that aired every Sunday morning between 6:30am and 7:00am during the period covered by this report. Three different issues are dealt with each week. Among the topics typically covered are: consumer matters, parenting issues, seniors and retirement, police and crime, women's issues, aging, poverty, and minority concerns.
