Broadcasting 24 hours a day, seven days a week, KHSU/KHSQ/KHSF/KHSG/KHSR provides North Coast California with more than 150 hours of news and information every week. We cover a full range of issues of concern to our local audiences.

The news staff determined the following issues of local concern in conversations with a number of residents from our broadcast area.

- Science

- **Talk Humboldt:** A KHSU-produced show hosted by Cal Poly Humboldt president Dr. Robert Jackson and College of the Redwood president Dr. Keith Flamer, talking with the area's business, political, economic and cultural leaders.

A typical show combines news, analysis, commentary, interviews, and special features on a range of topics, including those above. (Arts & Culture, Justice, Agriculture & Environment, Law and Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health and Science)
- **NPR's Weekend Edition** broadcasts Saturdays and Sundays from 5 to 9 a.m. A typical show combines news, analysis, commentary, interviews, and special features on a wide range of topics, including those above. (Arts & Culture, Agriculture & Environment, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science)
- **WBUR's Here and Now** broadcasts Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. A typical show combines news, analysis, commentary, interviews, and special features on a range of topics, including those above. (Arts & Culture, Justice, Agriculture & Environment, Law and Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health and Science)
- **PRI's The World** broadcasts Monday through Friday from noon to 2 to 4 p.m. It covers global news, including issues of Justice, Law, & Public Safety and Politics/Public Policy.
- **APM's Marketplace Morning Report** broadcasts Monday through Friday at 7:45 a.m. during Morning Edition. Business, finance, and market reporting.
- **BBC World News** broadcasts 7 p.m. overnight until 2 a.m. Monday to Sunday, bringing an international perspective to a local audience, including Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, Science, and Arts and Culture.
- **APM's Marketplace** broadcasts Monday through Friday at 2 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. Business, finance, and market reporting.

- **NPR's Latino USA** broadcasts Sundays 7-8 p.m. examining news, features, arts and cultural stories in the national Hispanic diaspora, including Justice, Law, & Public Safety and Politics/Public Policy, Arts and Culture.
- **PRX's Reveal** broadcasts Saturday from 4 to 5 p.m. with long-form investigative journalism, including Justice, Law, & Public Safety and Politics/Public Policy.
- **WNYC's Science Friday** broadcasts Friday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. features news, analysis, commentary, and interviews on a wide range of scientific topics, including Politics/Public Policy.
- **NPR's Fresh Air** broadcasts Monday through Friday from 1 to 2 p.m. and 8 to 9 p.m. The show primarily includes interviews with prominent figures in various fields, including: arts and entertainment, culture, journalism, and world news.
- **NPR's Code Switch/Life Kit** broadcasts Friday 1 to 2 p.m. Life Kit is experts giving advice from sleep to saving money to parenting and more. Code Switch increase coverage of race issues and reach out to new audiences. (Arts & Culture, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science)
- **NPR's Throughline** broadcasts Saturday 7 to 8 p.m. and Sunday 4 to 5 p.m. Throughline examines historical events to link them to current events. (Arts & Culture, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science)
- **NPR's Hidden Brain** broadcasts Sunday 10 to 11 a.m. Hidden Brain explores the unconscious patterns that drive human behavior and questions that lie at the heart of our complex and changing world. (Arts & Culture, Agriculture & Environment, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science)
- **NPR's It's Been a Minute** broadcasts Saturday 9 to 10 p.m. and Sunday 6 to 7 p.m. It's Been a Minute features people in the culture who deserve more attention, plus weekly wraps of the news with journalists in the know. (Arts & Culture, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science)
- **NPR's Our Body Politic** broadcasts Sunday 8 to 9 p.m. Our Body Politic features in-depth conversations about the economy, health, politics, education, the environment, through the lens of women's issues. (Arts & Culture, Agriculture & Environment, Justice, Law, & Public Safety, Politics/Public Policy, Public Health, and Science)
