In the days following, KPRC was first to report the very first Houston area men charged in connection with the riots.

Researchers behind this study say defining lives lost in terms economic cost isn't something they wanted to do or should have to do but they feel it's the only way to get the attention of lawmakers and policy makers who have the ability to do something about the gross disparities in health care.

Beginning on February 14, a historic winter storm plunged the entire state of Texas into record breaking cold weather, with ice, snow and frigid temperatures. Throughout the night and early

morning of the 14th/15th – the state's power suppliers began tripping offline sending the grid into a critical failure. Millions of people lost power, causing dozens of deaths. In the coming days, pipes broke in homes and businesses across the state, water supplies were cut off and endangered forcing millions to go under boil water notices. KPRC executed 3 days of extended news and weather coverage with additional newscasts, wall-to-wall coverage across morning and dayside shifts, slowly dialing back coverage as the crisis eased. Our coverage netted numerous 1st place finishes in morning, afternoon and late news time slots.
