Agents with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives detained a Burlington man in connection with a Saturday night shooting that put three 20-year-olds in the hospital.

According to Police, investigators carried out a warrant at the residence of 48-year-old Jason J. Eaton in a building right outside where the shooting took place on North Prospect Street.

Police say evidence from that search as well as other areas of investigation gave them probable cause.

Eaton is due to be arraigned today.

All three victims were struck, two in their torsos and one in the lower extremities. Police say two are U.S. citizens, and one is a legal resident.

The victims were transported to UVM Medical Center. Two victims are stable, while the other one has much more serious injuries, according to Burlington Police.

Police did not identify the victims names, but the families later released their names in a statement. Hisham Awartani is a student at Brown University in Rhode Island, Kinnan Abdalhamid is a student at Haverford College in Pennsylvania and Tahseen Ahmed is a student at Trinity College in Burlington, according to their family members.

Burlington's police chief and mayor are expected to hold a press conference about the incident on Monday.

The University of Vermont has canceled a lecture planned for this week featuring a Palestinian writer, saying it would be unable to ensure the safety of the event.

Mohammed El-Kurd, a Palestinian poet and journalist from Jerusalem, was scheduled to speak Thursday at UVM's Davis Center.

El-Kurd planned to discuss "representation and misrepresentation of Palestinians in the U.S.," according to an event description.

But V-T Digger reports on Saturday, the university's Division of Safety & Compliance emailed event organizers to tell them that it could not go forward as planned because in their judgment, based on global, national, and local events, they could not adequately provide safety and security for this event as it is currently planned.

The nonprofit Will Miller Social Justice Lecture Series, which was sponsoring the event along with the UVM departments of English and Sociology, called it "deeply disturbing."

Governor Phil Scott has joined a bipartisan group of U.S. governors calling for "immediate and continued aid to Israel in the weeks and months to come."

In an online post, Scott urged Congress to act quickly as Israel quote "responds to the heinous acts of terrorism committed against its people" by Hamas militants.

The post included a letter to Congressional leaders, calling for confirmations of key ambassadorships and military posts in the region as the war between Israel and Hamas continues.

Sixteen other governors signed the letter, including Democrats Kathy Hochul of New York, Maura Healey of Massachusetts and Ned Lamont of Connecticut.

The letter says that states have had to increase security in Jewish communities and houses of worship because of a "rise in antisemitism across the country." The governors asked Congress to ensure funding for local and state governments to "combat antisemitism at home."

The letter also commends President Joe Biden, as well as members of Congress for their support of Israel.

Vermont's congressional delegation is condemning the attacks on Israel.

The death toll in Israel and Palestine is at least 1,600 people after this weekend's violent attack by Hamas militants. That includes at least 11 Americans.

Israel has ordered a complete siege of the Gaza Strip and its defense minister says no food, water or fuel will be allowed into Gaza, where Hamas is holding dozens of hostages and threatening to begin executions.

Sen. Bernie Sanders, I-Vermont, posted online that he "condemns the horrifying attack on Israel by Hamas and Islamic Jihad. Bernie said there was no justification for the violence. "Innocent people on both sides will suffer hugely because of it. It must end now."

Senator Peter Welch posted that "The act of terrorism is unacceptable... These cycles of violence must stop."

And Congresswoman Becca Balint claimed she is standing with the people of Israel, called the attacks 'unprovoked', and said this violence must be loudly condemned.
