1. Fear, Worry, Anxiety

Pastor Ben took advantage of radio program 'Hope Generation' to address these very issues in a teaching entitled, 'What The Bible Says About Fear, Worry, and Anxiety'. The sermon, broken up into 2 programs, looked closely at the Gospel of Luke chapter 12 where Jesus teaches us that He knows the number of hairs on our heads, He feeds the sparrows, and clothes the lilies of the field.

As believers, we can take great hope and rest knowing that our God cares so much more about us than the lilies in the field, or the sparrows in the air, yet they are taken care of...so we will be to. So the answer to fear, worry, and anxiety...is simply trusting in Jesus.

2. Forgiveness

On August 10th, 2019, Jeffrey Epstein was found in his jail cell after he took his own life. Mr. Epstein, of course, was being held in a New York jail cell being accused of some significant crimes.

Pastor Adam Hulstrom took time on his Radio assignment “Shepherds Staff” to bring to light Jeffrey Epstein’s fate, and to remind us as Christians that we too are guilty, and fall short in so many ways. Jeffrey’s crimes were horrible, and even though we may not be guilty of the crimes he was accused of, we have fallen very short of the perfection God requires of us.

The 2 pieces of good news for us as Christians is this: we are completely forgiven in the eyes of our God because of the work of Jesus on the cross. And secondly, everyone around us, although guilty, is also completely forgiven.

So for us a Christians, we are encouraged by Pastor Adam to forgive one another, just as Christ has forgiven us.

3. Crisis Leadership – Jared Wilson’s death

On September 10th, 2019, Pastor Jared Wilson of Harvest Church in Southern California took his own life by suicide. Jared was a friend of Pastor Ben’s and he suffered with depression. Ben was deeply touched and impacted by Jared’s life and posed the question to a group of Pastors, how we can take this news of Jared’s death, and be leaders in our communities in this time of crisis.

On his weekly opportunity to preach at the Applegate Christian Fellowship, a church service broadcasted live on KAPL, Pastor Ben spoke about this issue, addressing the root problem associated with depression, and the ultimate cure for this disease, being the hope in Jesus Christ.

The same message he delivered to that group of pastors is the same message given to Ben’s Monday night service, that the God of Hope saved Ben from depression and suicidal thoughts, and he can to anyone who seeks God.

4. Christian Marriage
