KIAK provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

**POLITICS:** This has been a robust political year with many seats in Alaska up for election and the unfortunate death of our long-seated Congressman, Don Young, causing a special election in August. There is a local election on October 4<sup>th</sup> which took up most of the airwaves in September.

The permanent fund dividend was dispersed early, in late September and was an increase from previous years.

**PUBLIC HEALTH:** A prominent health issue continues to be COVID-19 and the news that the vaccine is available to children under 5 years old. Most people are encouraged to get booster shots. Mental health continues to be addressed throughout Q3, with the focus on young adults and the negative consequences of isolation & quarantining the past two years.
