## Quarterly Issues/Programs List

KIAK provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

POLITICS: This will be a robust political year with many seats in Alaska up for election and the unfortunate death of our long-seated Congressman, Don Young, causing a special election to happen in August. There is also discussion of the permanent fund dividend and whether the state will approve to give two PFDs this year.

PUBLIC HEALTH: A prominent health issue in Q2, 2022 was air quality - there are many forest fires, totaling over 1.5 million acres currently burning, causing smokey days and poor air quality in Fairbanks. Another public health issue continues to be COVID-19 and the news that the vaccine is available to children under 5 years old. Mental health continues to be addressed throughout Q2, with the focus on young adults and the negative consequences of isolation & quarantining the past two years.
