Alcohol Abuse /Gambling Addiction	Steppin' Out	Adam thinks he was born an alcoholic. His drinking lead to money problems, including divorce and jail for non-payment of debts. Alcohol/ Drug Abuse	Steppin' Out	Gary Mendell was a high-profile CEO of an exclusive hotel chain. His son, Brian, started abusing alcohol & drugs at 14 but sadly lost the battle. Now, Gary is the chairman of Shatterproof, an advocacy group seeking to increase funding for addiction research to spread awareness to families. Alessandra Rain, recognized expert on addiction drugs. Alcohol/ Drug Abuse	Steppin' Out	Lee McCormick hit the road as a singer songwriter. He plunged into the lifestyle head first & headstrong. He barely woke up one day and realized he had an out-of-control drug problem. Alcohol/ Drug Abuse/Gambling Addiction	Steppin' Out	Ron was introduced to alcohol at an early age. His drinking led to drugs, as he smoked pot & he soon became out-of-control. His mother gave him an ultimatum; her own brother committed suicide while in the throes of addiction. By the time Ron was 16 years old, he was sober. Ronnie's gambling began late in life. She moved to Las Vegas to find work but never found any work, the boyfriend she wanted, and her brother passed away. Alcohol/ Drug Abuse/Emotions Addicts	Steppin' Out	Gerry Cooney went from an amateur boxer to professional prizefighter at age 19. But as quickly as he rose through the ranks, he fell from greatness into a pit of alcohol. He drank to ease the pain but later realized he spent much of life trying to prove his father wrong. Aaron is an emotional addict and is a member of a fellowship, Emotions Anonymous, which offers a twelve-step style approach to dealing with emotional issues such as rage & depression, who also might see these issues as root causes of other addictive behaviors.	11/16/14	7:00-9:00am

		Wendy woke up one day to find herself in more than \$19,000 in debt, months behind in rent, and reliable on her parents generosity to pay for her most basic needs. Her eye-opening moment came when asking her parents again for money, and they told her she was draining their retirement assets.		
Alcohol Abuse/ Gambling Addiction	Steppin' Out	Andrew is a member of the "Double Winners" – people who achieved sobriety through both AA and Al-Anon. At age 15, his drinking had led to drug use, dropping out of school, getting kicked out of the house and getting in trouble with the law. Ron's first gamble came at age 10. He learned how to shoot dice on the street corner at night. After college, he joined an investment firm on Wall Street and it paid well. He ended up in legal trouble when he started covering losses with money his clients gave him to invest.	11/30/14	7:00-9:00am
Alcohol/ Drug Abuse/Gambling Addiction	Steppin' Out	Paul's last bet was many years ago. He started gambling when he was a youngster and as he grew up, he got married, but his gambling persisted, progressing to the point he was lying to his wife about his whereabouts. Mike is a recovering alcoholic who was enjoying his sobriety until he tried crystal meth for the first time. He soon found himself forgoing work & every other responsibility. Sexual Abuse- Addiction/ Alcohol Abuse/	Steppin' Out	John is an Al-Anon member, who found he could not be stable in relationships. Both his parents were alcoholics and abusive. His own mother sexually abused him. From this, he adopted a mantra that all people were not to be trusted. Barbara is a sex and love addict. Much as alcoholic parents introduce their kids to drinking, her own mother introduced her to the world of illicit sex. She began to think that if she wouldn't be having sex, she would not be "cool." Sex-Love Addiction	Steppin' Out	Dave is a sex and love addict. His father was very success-oriented and there was a lot of pressure to perform to high expectations both in school and life. Alcohol Abuse	Steppin' Out	Pete is an alcoholic who had his first drink at age 13. Despite being a child of alcoholics in recovery, he still became one himself. Josh ended his drinking at age 15. But his first drink was at age 8 or 9, when he and other kids discovered a stash of alcohol in their church basement.
