THE LAW ALSO UPHOLDS THE MINNESOTA STANDARD CLEAN INDOOR AIR AND BANNING THEM INSIDE GOV'T BUILDINGS. THE LAW ALLOWS COMMUNITIES TO ACT ON THEIR OWN BEHALF. WE DO KNOW THAT E-CIGARETTES CONTAIN THE HIGHLY ADDICTIVE CHEMICAL NICOTINE.
