Dear Mr. Palerm:

This is a follow up to our official must carry election dated September 15, 2008 and related correspondence. As you know, there was a period in which WMEI and WOST were off the air. We are now back on the air and will begin airing a new slate of programming that we believe will be exciting and of great interest to your subscribers. You should now be able to receive a quality signal off-air from WMEI-DT, Channel 14 or WOST-DT, Channel 22. We commit to delivering a usable signal to your head-end at our expense in the event that you are unable to receive a signal level sufficient under FCC Rules off-air.

Per discussions between Santiago Rubin, our manager in Puerto Rico, representatives of our programming affiliate MEGA TV, and you, it is agreed that CMCGPR will accept channel 45 on your Puerto Rican cable systems, waving our rights to our analog on-air position. We understand that channel 45 will air on a tier that is the same basic carriage as the other commercial stations in Puerto Rico.

We request that you begin carrying WMEI(TV) at 9 a.m. on November 23, 2009.
