Dear Bill,

I'm writing to follow-up on my last correspondence to you, as well as, to follow-up on the recent telephone conversation I have had with your representative Alvaro Pilar of Opus Consulting.

Since my last letter dated October 30<sup>th</sup> 2008, WMEI-TV (TeleMar) has received a formal written confirmation from Liberty Cablevision that TeleMar will be added to its cable system as soon as the hard line connection to its head end is effective. I believe the connections will be made by the end of this month or sooner. As you know, we are seeking the same result from OneLink Communications. Yet despite the fact that TeleMar has a legal right to its carriage by OneLink by virtue of its status as a FCC licensed full-power television station serving all of the rated market, TeleMar has done and will continue to do all we can to create a special partnership with OneLink. To that end, TeleMar will provide a positive "value added" element to OneLink's channel line-up based on our desire to arrive at a working relationship that is of benefit to both OneLink and TeleMar.

Mr. Pilar called to follow-up on a previous meeting. During this call Mr. Pilar informed me that during this difficult economic time for all the citizens of Puerto Rico it is OneLink's intent to launch a low cost tier to OneLink's cable services featuring TeleMar, as well as, the other local television stations on that tier (as you may know, we at TeleMar were very proactive when he originally came to us with this plan). He also told me that OneLink would be putting TeleMar on all the other cable channel line-ups being offered by OneLink. We appreciate this communication of your intent and trust that matters are moving along as discussed.

Nevertheless, as I previously indicated TeleMar would like to create a special relationship with OneLink and with that in mind has offered OneLink a new Spanish Language weather exclusive, AccuWeather, plus a new Spanish Language news channel exclusive, Hispanic News Network (HNN). In addition to TeleMar we will also provide this programming for your new "low cost" tier. We believe you will also benefit from including our two new 24 hours a day channels, plus TeleMar on your other full priced tiers. There will be no charge for either of the Spanish Language channels being offered by us and almost all advertising time available will belong to OneLink for sale to its clients. What we are asking in exchange for these two sources of programming that will be of value to your subscribers is an immediate commitment to the carriage of TeleMar and to have that carriage on a channel that will approximate our new digital service that will begin Feb 17, 2009.

It is important that you know that we have negotiated the broadcast, as well as, the cable rights for these two significant content channels as part of our plan to offer the weather and news exclusively to the local cable systems. This exclusive content will provide the local cable systems programming which will not be offered to your satellite competitors. TeleMar, Accuweather and Hispanic News Network will be attractive additions as you look for new subscribers.

As discussed in my meeting with Mr. Pilar, TeleMar would like to be on Channel 14 which will be our over-the-air channel after the FCC mandated Digital Television Conversion is complete. However, it is imperative to us to be on the OneLink system now as we are already offering significant public interest programming on the station. In fact, during much of the day WMEI is broadcasting the same AccuWeather and HNN programming products we are offering to provide to OneLink at no charge. As these two stand-alone channels and TeleMar are added to your system we will discontinue almost all of the over the air use of this programming.

Obviously, TeleMar is committed to delivering a signal as defined by FCC rules to your cable head-end at our expense. To insure that we are able to accomplish this, please provide us with a technical contact who we can work with in determining whether an alternative delivery mechanism is necessary, and to coordinate access to your head-end for the installation of any additional equipment that may be necessary for the delivery of a usable signal.

We look forward to your cooperation and we really want to work with you to promote the value of OneLink.
