Section A: Newscast Overview

KXPO Radio produces eight local newscasts weekdays. In depth "morning drive" reports air following ABC news at 6, 7, and 8am. Other reports occur following ABC news at 10am, 11am, and 12pm and independently at 4:30pm and 5:35pm. KAUJ Radio carries identical news coverage as KXPO from 6:00 AM to 10:00 AM weekdays.

News treatments: The length of each of our lead or features stories described below is between thirty-seconds and two minutes-thirty seconds.

News Cycle: Exclusive stories run in each of the daily local newscasts before being archived. As an example: A local story or feature will air eight times in the course of a day, once in each newscast. In addition, these stories are available to our audience ondemand via our station website for one week from date of first broadcast.

Sample: Below is a sample which represents the typical local news stories produced daily by our stations.

April 2013

April 1st, 2013: News Director Scott Karnik interviewed Grafton School Superintendent Jack Maus. Maus talked about a new space study authorized by the Grafton School Board to help the school board decide whether to upgrade Central Middle School or build a new middle school on-site with Grafton High School and Century Elementary School. An architect was selected for that study.

April 2nd, 2013: Reported the City of Grafton had declared an emergency to help prepare for an imminent spring flood. City Mayor Chris West was interviewed about the emergency dike work.

May 2013

May 1st, 2013: News Director Scott Karnik interviewed Danielle Osowski, student and resident of Grafton. Osowski won a North Dakota award for explaining why she wore her seatbelt. ND DOT officials in Grafton told KXPO News wearing seatbelts is critically important and they're getting more people to do so.

May 10th, 2013: News Director Scott Karnik interviewed Grafton resident Tom Campbell. Campbell paid 400-dollars for a hamburger at Westside Drive-In during a charity auction for Unity Medical Center in Grafton.

June 2013

June 3rd, 2013: News Director Scott Karnik interviewed one of the organizers of the 17th annual Cavalier Motorcycle Ride-In: Nancy Jensen. Interest in the ride-in is increasing, due in part to expanded publicity. Jensen says events like that motorcycle ride-in are critical to the economy of a small, rural North Dakota town like Cavalier.

June 4th, 2013: KXPO News Director Scott Karnik interviewed North Dakota First Lady Betsy Dalrymple. Dalrymple visited Grafton for a health event and to promote the inaugural Imagination Library Conference. Imagination Library promotes reading for children of an early age in North Dakota to better prepare them to read in school.

Section B: Special and Non-Broadcast Events

1. Rod & Reel Rally Registration

Each year, KXPO & KAUJ partner with the Drayton Area Chamber of Commerce and the Red River Resort to generate entries for the regions largest catfishing tournament. Proceeds benefit the Drayton Area Chamber.

2. First Care Health Center Golf Scramble Fundraiser

Simmons Broadcasting was a hole sponsor at the First Care Health Center Golf Scramble Fundraiser. Proceeds from the event benefit First Care Health Center.

3. Communications Student Intern

From April 18, 2013 to June 15, 2013, KXPO & KAUJ had an intern. Taylor Lehar graduated early from Park River High School and she interned with our stations to gain insight on media influence in marketing and communication. She will be attending UND in the fall for Communications.

4. \$5,000 worth of marketing donated to Grafton SummerFest Event

Simmons Broadcasting was an in kind sponsor for Grafton SummerFest and in that donated over \$5,000.00 worth of advertising, news and promotional coverage for the four-day celebration held annually in Grafton. The SummerFest event was June 27th through 30th and the proceeds went to the Grafton Area Chamber of Commerce.

5. Relay for Life

KXPO staff members Ryan Johnston and Brian VanBruggen represented out radio group to provide professional DJ service and MC service to the Walsh County Relay for Life event held June 7th, 2013 in Grafton.

Kickin Up Kountry

For promotional purposes, KXPO staff member Ryan Johnston broadcast his morning show from the Kickin Up Kountry Country Music Festival in Hallock. This was done at no charge to promote the concert.

7. Put Minto on the Map Event

On June 15, staff members Ryan Johnston and Sean Ford broadcast remotely from the "Put Minto on the Map" event. KXPO helped draw a crowd to the event to

help the City of Minto break the Guinness record for the largest pot of chili made and the most people served.

Six times daily there was a three to four minute segment to offer detailed reporting of flooding and flood warnings to the public. This occurred twice this spring so flood report were added to the lineup from March 18 to April 12 and May 16 to June 7
