### Section A: Newscast Overview

KAUJ FM Radio produces 5 daily newscasts. Five 2 minute 'morning drive' reports air at 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9am.

News Treatments: The nominal length of each of our lead or feature stories described below is between thirty-seconds and two minutes-thirty seconds.

News Cycle: Exclusive stories run in each of the daily local newscasts before being archived. As an example: A local story or feature will air 5 times in the course of a day, once in each newscast. In addition these stories are available to our audience ondemand via our station website for one week from date of first broadcast.

The attached stories are representative of the local news content we produce on a daily basis:

#### July 2015

July 14th

Reported that the Grafton City Council had approved a resolution of support concerning flood control. The resolution implemented the authority and means to create a flood risk reduction project for controlling Park River food waters as to eliminate or reduce damage to the city and it's residents. Language in the resolution stated that the city would now proceed with and continue its efforts to create and establish the Grafton Flood Risk Reduction Project consisting of a bypass channel or channels and tie back levees

July 16th

Reported that the Grafton Police Department working with Walsh County Communications implemented an anonymous tip reporting system service called TIP411. the service is intended to be a valuable tool for the department in solving a myriad of crimes in the community

#### August 2015

August 11th

Reported that emergency services, first responders and officials from the surrounding area were to conduct a simulated incident in Grafton the following day. The main objectives of the drill were to include testing the County's emergency operations plan along with communications and command structures. The exercise was coordinated by Wenk Associates from Mandan ND

August 28th

Reported that three people were arrested following a rash of vehicle break-ins that had occurred in the city and surrounding area. The three suspects were brought up on numerous charges including possession of stolen properties, possession of drug paraphernalia and forgery. The arrest resulted in the recovery of many stolen items.

#### September 2015

### September 9th

Reported on a public hearing for taxpayers in the Park River School district. The purpose of the meeting was to give citizens an opportunity to present oral or written comments regarding a potential tax levy increase of 36.42 percent. The increase was to pay for renovations in the Park River Area School building.

## September 16th

Reported that Grafton resident and District 19 state senator Tom Campbell had formed an exploratory committee for a potential run for the office of Governor. The committee was formed to help him gauge voter interest in his potential candidacy. Campbell said the committee would take up to a month to complete its study, at which point he would make an official public announcement on his decision to run or not

#### Section B: Special and Non-Broadcast Events

Throughout the year Simmons Stations assist local groups and organizations with the promotion and or cosponsorship of various activities and events. Our involvement may include contributions of in-kind advertising, cash donations, company staff donating their own time to assist with a given event, etc. Below are some examples which are representative of these efforts.

#### 1- 8th Annual Tractor Cruise

On the weekend of July 11<sup>th</sup> Simmons Stations hosted our 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Antique Tractor, Car and Pick-up Cruise. Entrants drove their 'old iron' from Edmore, ND to Lawton, ND. This event draws large numbers of participants and spectators each year.

#### 2- Sports Guide

Twice each year (fall & winter) Simmons Multimedia produces The Area Sports Guide. This printed booklet features over 40 pages of area high school team photos, game schedules and features. The guides are made available free to the general public. An online version is also available on our website sports page.

#### 3- Garage & Rummage Sale Locator

Simmons Multimedia Stations post area garage and rummage sales on an interactive webpage that shows sale locations/street addresses, sale hours, sale items and a map with driving directions. The Garage and Rummage Sale Locator is made available free as a service to our listeners and the general public.

#### 4- Client Outreach/Marketing Seminars

Throughout the year, Simmons Stations offer free marketing seminars to area businesses. The focus of these meetings is on attracting and retaining customers using total marketing solutions including radio/TV/print/digital/outdoor. Businesses who participate are under no obligation to purchase advertising from Simmons Stations.
