Section A: Newscast Overview

KAUJ FM Radio produces 5 daily newscasts. Five 2 minute 'morning drive' reports air at 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9am.

News Treatments: The nominal length of each of our lead or feature stories described below is between thirty-seconds and two minutes-thirty seconds.

News Cycle: Exclusive stories run in each of the daily local newscasts before being archived. As an example: A local story or feature will air 5 times in the course of a day, once in each newscast. In addition these stories are available to our audience ondemand via our station website for one week from date of first broadcast.

The attached stories are representative of the local news content we produce on a daily basis:

January 2015

January 22nd

Walsh county Sheriff Ron Jurgens had discussed the need for a PREA audit of the Walsh County Jail with county commissioners. PREA stands for the Prison Rape Elimination Act and Jurgens told commissioners due to a recent controversy at the county jail, the county was required to undergo an audit to ensure compliance with the act or risk closure of the facility. Commissioners approved \$3,860 in funds to cover the cost of the audit.

January 28th

Reported on a meeting of Grafton's Flood Risk Reduction Citizens Advisory Group. The plan to remove the city from the 100 year flood plain was discussed in greater deal as this was the 2nd meeting for group. Two options were discussed at the meeting, with the committee favoring option 1 with an 8.5 mile levee that would give the city additional capacity against a flood event from the South. The goal to begin construction on the project was set for sometime in 2016. Construction was expected to take 2 years.

February 2015

February 11th

Reported on First Care Health Center in Park River's participation in the National Giving Hearts Day Fundraiser. Funds raised during the event were to be used towards the purchase of a hematology analyzer for the facility.

February 24th

Reported that The North Dakota Agricultural Products Utilization Commission (APUC had recently awarded funding requests for four projects totaling \$320,394.00 at its quarterly meeting February 19th at the North Dakota Department of Commerce in Bismarck. The Pembina/Walsh County Livestock Processing Committee from Grafton was awarded \$35,170 for consultant and legal fees related to fundraising and the construction process for the design, procurement and placement of equipment for the

establishment of a multi-species slaughter and processing facility to provide custom meat processing services to area livestock producers and plant processed meat products to the public.

March 2015

March 11th

Reported that the Grafton City Council had recently approved second reading of an amendment to a health and sanitation ordinance in the city relating to structures without utility service. Language in the ordinance now required that for a structure to be classified with "services connected," electric and water service would have to be available to all outlets and fixtures within the residence. Violation of the ordinance would be a misdemeanor offense.

March 27th

Reported on the Grafton Area Chamber of Commerce election of two new directors to its board. The chamber had also held it's election of officers at it's regular meeting on March 15th. Officers elected included Brad Moe who was elected to serve another term as president. Erin Morgan would serve as VP and Dennis Sevigny was elected as treasurer. The Chamber Board would meet the third Thursday of every month at 7:00 a.m.

Section B: Special and Non-Broadcast Events

Throughout the year Simmons Stations assist local groups and organizations with the promotion and or cosponsorship of various activities and events. Our involvement may include contributions of in-kind advertising, cash donations, company staff donating their own time to assist with a given event, etc. Below are some examples which are representative of these efforts.
