Section A: Newscast Overview

KAUJ FM Radio produces 5 daily newscasts. Five 2 minute 'morning drive' reports air at 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9am.

News Treatments: The nominal length of each of our lead or feature stories described below is between thirty-seconds and two minutes-thirty seconds.

News Cycle: Exclusive stories run in each of the daily local newscasts before being archived. As an example: A local story or feature will air 5 times in the course of a day, once in each newscast. In addition these stories are available to our audience ondemand via our station website for one week from date of first broadcast.

The attached stories are representative of the local news content we produce on a daily basis:

OCTOBER 2015

10/18/15

Reported that fire fighters from Grafton, Minto and Park River had battled a fire in a potato warehouse East of Grafton early that Saturday morning.

The building was a total loss and arson was not ruled out as a possible cause. The warehouse was owned and operated by ND State Senator Tom Campbell also of Campbell farms.

10/26/15

Reported that a Grafton man was behind bars in the Walsh County Jail after photos of young boys were found on his phone. 31 year old Adam Schnellback was reported to be facing life in prison if found guilty of all charges.

Evidence had been collected against the accused involving at least two different child victims he had been babysitting. Anyone with additional information on Schnellback was asked to contact the Grafton Police Department.

NOVEMBER 2015

11/4/15

Reported that the Grafton Public Utilities Committee had recommended increasing the monthly charge utility customers pay for pest control from three to five dollars. The money was to be used for extra mosquito control during especially bad years as the current funds would often run out eary when residents were being charged three dollars per month.

11/17/15

Reported that Grafton resident and State Senator Tom Campbell had decided against seeking the Republican nomination for Governor. Campbell had been considering a run and had formed an exploratory committee to judge the feasibility of winning should he decide to run. Campbell told KXPO that one of the reasons he had decided against running was the all but certain candidacy of Attorney General Wayne Stenehjem.

11/30/15

Reported that the Red Cross had been called to Grafton to assist the displaced residents of a morning house fire. The Red Cross had arrived that Sunday morning to provide the family, which included three adults and two small children, with financial assistance for immediate needs along with clothing and lodging. The fire was reported to have started in a clothes dryer that rapidly spread to the rest of the house. The home was a total loss.

DECEMBER 2015

12/18/15

Reported that potato stocks, a major crop in the Grafton and surrounding area, were up by 15 percent from the previous year. At the time of the report, growers, dealers and processors across the state had held 1.95 billion pounds of potatoes in storage.

12/14/15

Reported that the Minto High School had been named the North Dakota state winner in the Samsung Solve for Tomorrow Contest, a program encouraging teachers and students to solve real world issues in their community using skills in science, technology, engineering and math. The students planned to use the \$20,000 they received to study the impacts of agricultural drainage and its effects on an already flood prone city.

Section B: Special and Non-Broadcast Events
