The Missoula County COVID-19 Testing Center is open at the Missoula Fairgrounds. Tests are by appointment only. If you have COVID-19 symptoms (cough, fever, difficulty breathing) or are caring for someone with symptoms, call 406-258-INFO (4636) and select Option 2 to speak to a nurse. Missoula County residents who meet CDC's testing guidance for groups one and two are eligible. These groups include people with symptoms of COVID-19 who have an underlying health conditions or are over 65 years of age, pregnant, or immunocompromised. Additionally, those first responders and health care workers with symptoms are eligible for testing due to patient interactions and their role in our health care infrastructure.
