An international organization which uses local 'mobile packs' for people to volunteer and pack meals for people around the world struggling with undernutrition. They asked for volunteers and donations.

This program provides Christmas gifts to children whose parents are incarcerated during the Christmas season. An appeal was made to listeners to help provide gifts for these children

An international group that provides shoeboxes filled with hygiene items, toys and school supplies. They asked for families and children to help to fill the shoeboxes
Local Homelessness	11/20 – 11/24/23	Airings between 6:30 am – 8:30 am	1 minute each airing	Mike and Andi interview Captain David Womack from the Salvation Army of Marathon County. They discussed the needs of local homeless population. Providing temporary housing, food, Christmas gifts and training,
Hearts of Hope program for local children/family in need	12/4 -12/8/23	Airings between 6:30 am – 8:40 am	1 minute each airing	Mike and Andi interview Sue Thompson from Hearts of Hope which helps local children in need receive Christmas gifts and they encouraged listeners to participate.
