THESE MEANINGFUL PROGRAMS HELP ONE TO MANAGE LIFE'S ISSUES, ARE BASED ON BIBLICAL PRINCIPLES AND PRECEPTS, AND ARE ACCOMPLISHED THROUGH A LIVE PHONE-IN PROGRAM.

'YOU AND ME' IS AIRED LIVE EACH WEEKDAY NIGHT (FROM MIDNIGHT TO 3 A.M.) WITH THE HOST ANSWERING QUESTIONS, OFFERING ADVICE, AND INVOLVING OTHER CALLERS IN RECOMMENDING GUIDANCE AND DISCUSSING AND PRAYING FOR A VARIETY OF TOPICS. ISSUES COVERED INCLUDE: FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS, RACE RELATIONS, WOMEN'S ISSUES, HEALTH, COMMUNITY VENTURES, AND CO-OPS; TEENAGE ISSUES; AS WELL AS FINANCIAL ADVICE, ADULT EDUCATION, SUBSTANCE ABUSE - PREVENTION - RECOVERY; SOUP KITCHENS, HOMELESS MINISTRIES, AND HELP FOR IMPOVERISHED PEOPLE. THE HOURS THAT THE PROGRAM IS AIRED HAS SHOWN TO BE AN IDEAL TIME TO HELP THE LONELY, THE HURTING, THOSE THAT ARE DISTRESSED, DEJECTED, AND STRUGGLING.

'YOU AND ME' IS NOT SCRIPTED, THERE IS USUALLY NO FORMATE, AND AS YOU MIGHT IMAGINE, IT WOULD BE COST PROHIBITIVE FOR USE TO TAPE RECORD AND SAVE EACH THREE-HOUR PRESENTATION. TAPED PROGRAMS ARE USED ONLY IN AN EMERGENCY, WHERE THE LIVE HOST COULD NOT MAKE IT TO THE STUDIO, AND A GUEST HOST COULD NOT BE SUMMONED IN TIME. I'M SURE THAT THERE ARE MANY OTHER CATEGORIES I HAVE FAILED TO MENTION, AS ON CERTAIN OCCASIONS, THE HOST WILL SELECT A SPECIFIC THEME FOR THAT NIGHT.
