April 6, 2022 – Early Voting / Education

Promoted early voting in Kendall County which starts on April 25th and goes thru May 3rd - Election Day is May 7th - and the last day to register to vote is “tomorrow” - April 7th. On the ballot is Proposition 1 for Boerne ISD and a bond worth 162 million dollars. In the bond includes the construction of a new elementary school and needed upgrades to manage the growth. Plus, safety improvements, technology upgrades to compete, and purchasing land for the future.

April 15, 2022 – Drought / Water Conservation

The City of Boerne is officially in Stage 2 for Water Conservation as the last time Boerne had more than an inch of rainfall was last November. This means both residential and commercial utility customers are required to limit the use of water for landscape irrigation. Sprinklers for lawns, and gardens are only on your designated day based on your address, and only between the hours of 7 p.m. and 11 a.m. You can water your lawn by hand with a hose at any time. Other ideas to save water include taking shorter showers, fix leaks in toilets, and don't let the water run down the drain when you brush your teeth. With the dry grass and brush, our fire departments have been busy lately.

May 5, 2022 – Community Prayer

The Nation Day of Prayer is always the 1st Thursday in May, and the Boerne Ministerial Alliance made up of over 40 Pastors, Chaplains, Priests and Leaders hosted a special ecumenical service at Saint John Lutheran Church on Rosewood Avenue starting at 7pm. Prayer for our city, our country and our leaders is the focus, plus prayers for the church and our families, and prayers in worship with words and song.

June 9, 2022 – Hunger / Food Bank

June 10, 2022 - Traffic

The Transportation Committee of Boerne comes to a consensus on draft policy recommendations and the headline is Eminent Domain is the last option.

June 15, 2022 – PSA on Water Conservation

Boerne Radio aired a dozen messages on Water Conservation in Boerne with tips including: Check your faucets and pipes for leaks, take faster showers, and turn off the water while you're brushing your teeth. Only water on your designated day, only water from 7pm to 11am, hand water with a hose anytime. If you're not sure when your designated day is, find it on the City of Boerne's website.

June 28, 2022 – School Safety

After the tragedy in Uvalde, The Boerne ISD will provide a full-time School Resource Officer on each campus.
