DATE / TIME AIRED: January 5/6, 2013

**DESCRIPTION:** IF YOU'VE MADE THE DECISION TO STOP SMOKING, THERE IS NO REASON TO GO IT ALONE ACCORDING TO THE AMERICAN LUNG ASSOCIATION IN WISCONSIN. **PROGRAM: SNOW PLOW SAFETY** 

LENGTH: 90 seconds

DATE / TIME AIRED: January 19/20, 2013

**DESCRIPTION:** SNOWPLOW CREWS KEEP ROADS OPEN AND SAFE FOR TRAVELING, EVEN DURING THE COLDEST AND SNOWIEST MONTHS OF THE YEAR. REMEMBER TO EXERCISE CAUTION WHENEVER A SNOWPLOW IS NEAR AND LIMIT NON-ESSENTIAL TRAVEL DURING THE WORST DRIVING CONDITIONS.

**ISSUES COVERED: SAFETY** 

**PROGRAM:** WINTER WEATHER AND DRIVING

LENGTH: 90 seconds

DATE / TIME AIRED: January 26/27, 2013

**DESCRIPTION:** IT IS IMPORTANT TO START TAKING PREVENTIVE MEASURES FOR WINTER WEATHER. WINTER STORMS ARE CONSIDERED DECEPTIVE KILLERS BECAUSE MOST DEATHS ARE INDIRECTLY RELATED TO THE STORM SUCH AS TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS ON ICY OR SNOW-COVERED ROADS, PROLONGED EXPOSURE TO THE COLD OR INDOOR CARBON MONOXIDE POISONING. TYPICALLY THERE ARE AROUND TWENTY THOUSAND VEHICLE ACCIDENTS IN WISCONSIN DURING WINTER MONTHS.

PROGRAM: FEBRUARY IS AMERICAN HEART MONTH.

**LENGTH: 90 seconds** 

DATE / TIME AIRED: February 2/3, 2013

**DESCRIPTION:** ONE IN THREE AMERICAN ADULTS HAVE ONE OR MORE TYPES OF CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE, YET MORE THAN EIGHTY PERCENT OF CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE CAN BE PREVENTED. HEART DISEASE IS THE NUMBER-ONE HEALTH THREAT FOR BOTH MEN AND WOMEN.

PROGRAM: NATIONAL CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH MONTH

**DESCRIPTION:** EACH FEBRUARY, THE AMERICAN DENTAL ASSOCIATION (A-D-A) SPONSORS NATIONAL CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH MONTH TO RAISE AWARENESS ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF ORAL HEALTH. DEVELOPING GOOD HABITS AT AN EARLY AGE AND SCHEDULING REGULAR DENTAL VISITS HELPS CHILDREN GET A GOOD START ON A LIFETIME OF HEALTHY TEETH AND GUMS.

**PROGRAM: CYBER BULLYING**

**DESCRIPTION:** YOUNG PEOPLE ARE USING THE INTERNET MORE THAN EVER AND FOR MANY YOUTH, THE INTERNET ISN'T SIMPLY A CONVENIENT WAY TO RESEARCH OR A FUN AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITY-

IT'S A BIG PART OF THEIR SOCIAL LIFE. BUT LIKE MANY OTHER SOCIAL SITUATIONS, SOME YOUNG PEOPLE BULLY. ONLINE BULLYING, CALLED CYBER BULLYING, HAPPENS WHEN CHILDREN AND TEENS USE THE INTERNET, CELL PHONES OR OTHER DEVICES TO SEND OR POST TEXT OR IMAGES INTENDED TO HURT OR EMBARRASS ANOTHER PERSON.

**DESCRIPTION:** THERE IS A LOT TO BE GAINED FOR STUDENTS AND FARMERS WHEN FARM-TO-SCHOOL PROGRAMS HELP FUEL WISCONSIN CAFETERIA LINES. SCHOOL FOOD SERVICE DIRECTORS ACROSS THE STATE, AND NATION, ARE STARTING TO TAKE A MORE SERIOUS LOOK AT PROGRAMS CONNECTING LOCAL FARMERS TO THE PROCESS OF FEEDING SCHOOL CHILDREN. AND NOW WITH WHAT SOME REGARD AS THE PEAK OF THE GAMBLING SEASON, THE NCAA BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT, LOOKING FOR WAYS TO GET A LITTLE EXTRA COULD LEAD TO BAD HABITS.
