DESCRIPTION: DOESN'T HAVE TO BE A SCORCHER DAY TO BE DANGEROUS FOR KIDS. THE TEMPERATURE IN A CAR IS HIGHER THAN IT IS OUTSIDE AND FOR CHILDREN, THE EFFECTS ARE FAR WORSE THAN FOR ADULTS. IT IS ALSO NOT SAFE TO LEAVE A CHILD IN THE VEHICLE – EVEN IF THE WINDOW IS CRACKED.

PROGRAM: Born Learning- Early Childhood Development

LENGTH: 90 seconds

DATE / TIME AIRED: July 20/21, 2013

DESCRIPTION: PARENTS AND CAREGIVERS OF YOUNG CHILDREN UNDERSTAND THE EARLY YEARS ARE IMPORTANT, YET MANY AREN'T SURE HOW TO ENCOURAGE EARLY LEARNING OR FEEL THERE'S NOT ENOUGH TIME TO DO WHAT IT TAKES TO HELP CHILD

SUCCEED IN SCHOOL. IN RESPONSE, BORN LEARNING, AN INNOVATIVE PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT CAMPAIGN TO HELP PARENTS, CAREGIVERS AND COMMUNITIES WAS CREATED TO PROVIDE QUALITY EARLY LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG CHILDREN. BORN LEARNING HAS THREE CORNERSTONES: AWARENESS- PROVIDING IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT HOW YOUNG CHILDREN LEARN.

PROGRAM: Slow Down in Work Zones

LENGTH: 90 seconds

DATE / TIME AIRED: July 27/28, 2013

DESCRIPTION: WITH SO MANY ROADS CURRENTLY UNDER CONSTRUCTION, MOTORISTS FACE THE CHALLENGE OF SAFELY MANEUVERING IN AND OUT OF WORK ZONES WHILE MAINTAINING A SAFE DISTANCE FROM CONSTRUCTION WORKERS, HEAVY MACHINERY AND OTHER MOTORISTS. WISCONSIN STATE PATROL SUPERINTENDENT DAVID COLLINS SAYS WORK ZONES ARE DANGEROUS UNDER THE BEST OF CIRCUMSTANCES, BUT REACTION TIME AND MARGIN FOR ERROR ARE REDUCED SIGNIFICANTLY IF A DRIVER IS SPEEDING, TAILGATING OR NOT PAYING ATTENTION TO RAPIDLY CHANGING TRAFFIC SITUATIONS.

PROGRAM: CHILDREN'S VISION AND LEARNING MONTH

LENGTH: 90 seconds

DATE / TIME AIRED: August 3/4, 2013

DESCRIPTION: "AUGUST IS CHILDREN'S VISION AND LEARNING MONTH" CAMPAIGN IS WORKING TO RAISE AWARENESS ABOUT THE IMPORTANT CONNECTION BETWEEN VISION AND LEARNING. SIXTY PERCENT OF STUDENTS IDENTIFIED AS "PROBLEM LEARNERS" HAVE UNDETECTED VISION PROBLEMS ACCORDING TO THE AMERICAN OPTOMETRIC ASSOCIATION. VISION IS MORE THAN TWENTY/TWENTY. NEAR DISTANCES, DEPTH PERCEPTION, EYE COORDINATION AND NUMEROUS OTHER VISUAL SKILLS ARE REQUIRED IN THE LEARNING PROCESS

PROGRAM: Immunizations

DATE / TIME AIRED: August 10/11, 2013

DESCRIPTION: AUGUST IS RECOGNIZED AS NATIONAL IMMUNIZATION AWARENESS MONTH. THE CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION WANTS TO INCREASE AWARENESS ABOUT IMMUNIZATIONS ACROSS THE LIFE SPAN, FROM INFANTS TO THE ELDERLY.

PROGRAM: Cyber bullying a problem among today's youth.

PROGRAM: Motorist, walkers and bicyclists watch out for each other

DATE / TIME AIRED: August 24/25, 2013

DESCRIPTION: SCHOOL WILL BE STARTING SOON AND SAFETY OFFICIALS ARE ASKING MOTORIST, WALKERS AND BICYCLISTS TO WATCH OUT FOR EACH OTHER. NOW IS A GOOD TIME FOR PARENTS TO TEACH OR REVIEW WITH CHILDREN SAFE TRAVEL RULES. MOTORISTS ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR CHILD PEDESTRIAN SAFETY.

PROGRAM: Classroom Connection

DATE / TIME AIRED: August 31/September 1, 2013

DESCRIPTION: AS RESOURCES ARE TIGHTER THAN EVER, EDUCATORS ARE HOPING PARENTS WILL TAKE AN ACTIVE ROLE IN CHILDREN'S EDUCATION. THE WISCONSIN EDUCATION ASSOCIATION COUNCIL SAID BUDGET CUTS AT SCHOOL AND ECONOMIC PRESSURES FACING STUDENTS AT HOME, MEAN PARENTS FORGING PARTNERSHIPS WITH SCHOOLS IS MORE IMPORTANT THAN EVER.

PROGRAM: High School Dropout Prevention

DATE / TIME AIRED: September 14/15, 2013

DESCRIPTION: THE MORE PARENTS GET INVOLVED, THE BETTER CHILDREN DO IN EVERY WAY-TEST SCORES, ATITUDE, EVEN THE LIKELIHOOD OF GRADUATION AND A COLLEGE EDUCATION. REGARDLESS OF THE PARENT'S LEVEL OF EDUCATION, SIMPLE THINGS CAN BE DONE TO HELP, LIKE MAKING SURE THEY WAKE UP ON TIME FOR SCHOOL EVERY DAY. PARENTS SHOULD SHOW CHILDREN THEIR EDUCATION IS IMPORTANT.

DATE / TIME AIRED: September 21/22, 2013

DESCRIPTION: THE ACTION ON THE FOOTBALL FIELD TRIGGERS BETTING ACTION ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND RIGHT HERE IN WISCONSIN. SPORTS BETTING IS ONLY LEGAL IN TWO STATES, NEVADA AND OREGON, BUT THAT DOES NOT STOP PEOPLE FROM PLACING BETS ON COLLEGE AND PRO FOOTBALL.

ISSUES COVERED: SAFETY

PROGRAM: Slow Down in Work Zones

LENGTH: 90 seconds

DATE / TIME AIRED: September 28/29, 2013

DESCRIPTION: WITH SO MANY ROADS CURRENTLY UNDER CONSTRUCTION, MOTORISTS FACE THE CHALLENGE OF SAFELY MANEUVERING IN AND OUT OF WORK ZONES WHILE MAINTAINING A SAFE DISTANCE FROM CONSTRUCTION WORKERS, HEAVY MACHINERY AND OTHER MOTORISTS. WISCONSIN STATE PATROL SUPERINTENDENT DAVID COLLINS SAYS WORK ZONES ARE DANGEROUS UNDER THE BEST OF CIRCUMSTANCES, BUT REACTION TIME AND MARGIN FOR ERROR ARE REDUCED SIGNIFICANTLY IF A DRIVER IS SPEEDING, TAILGATING OR NOT PAYING ATTENTION TO RAPIDLY CHANGING TRAFFIC SITUATIONS.
