WHBQ maintains a file of applications/resumes for review as job openings occur. These applications/resumes are kept "active" for six months from the date they are received.

Walk-in Hours

In order to maximize the Stations' accessibility, the Station maintains regular hours for applicants to complete applications in person. In addition, applications are available for the general public in the main lobby for extended hours and on weekends.

Section 3: Supplemental Outreach Activities

1. Internship Program

WHBQ sponsors internships each semester for junior and senior college students who are enrolled in classes related to the broadcast industry and/or business curriculums. The students work approximately 24 hours per week and receive college credit at the successful conclusion of their internship. Qualified students have the opportunity to work in all aspects of the station's operations. Students are evaluated at the end of the internship and the evaluations are submitted to their respective college or university. Following is a list of colleges and universities from which we recruit: University of Memphis, Russ College, Christian Brothers University, Rhodes College, Le Moyne-Owen College, Middle Tennessee State University, University of Missouri, Vanderbilt University, Mississippi State University, University of Mississippi, Southern Mississippi State, University of Alabama, Brigham Young University, Arkansas State University, and University of Tennessee.

2. Participation in Scholarship Programs

• Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media, Inc.

Established in 1989, the Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media is a non-profit organization whose mission is to create career opportunities in the media industry for minority youth through a program that focuses on scholastic achievement, direct work experience and professional development. Students in the program work in media companies each summer and during school breaks, from high school through college. The students earn both salaries and match scholarship funds to be sued for college tuition and related expenses. Over a period of up to five years, the students experience numerous aspects of corporate operation and develop professional and practical skills that will help prepare them for their careers, many of which begin at the companies where the students interned. Fox Television Stations has been a corporate partner in this program since its inception and two of the Company's executives are on the Foundation's board. WHBQ is currently sponsoring one scholarship student in the Emma L. Bowen program.

Benjamin L. Hooks Fellowship Award

Fox Television Stations, Inc in conjunction with the New York University Tisch School of the Arts provides an annual monetary award to eight minority students who are majoring in a media-related field. This grant is used toward the cost of tuition.

3. Job Fairs

Our stations regularly participate in local and national career/job fairs. Job Fairs provide applicants and potential candidates with the opportunity to learn about Fox Television Stations and the job opportunities and internship/mentoring programs available with our group. 4. Staff Training

Fox Station Sales, an in-house national sales organization, maintains a program to train new sales account executives. This program consists of both coursework and hands-on training. At the end of the program, individuals are assigned to the Company's television stations and sales offices throughout the United States.

WHBQ also engages in on-site training which resulted in the following internal promotions: PT to FT Production Technician, 2-Directors to Producers.

5. Transitional Employment Program

WHBQ FOX 13 participates in the on-going transitional program with the University of Memphis, which has been very successful in identifying qualified individuals. Minorities and women are encouraged to apply to this program. The part-timers work a 17 hour work week with a professional staff. The object of the program is to develop individuals who have little or no experience in the broadcasting industry for entry-level positions.
