They were on the show approximately 11 minutes and discussed in further detail specifics about the upcoming GE expansion, and what folks need to do to apply, etc.

<u>Children's Trust Endowment:</u> Jennifer Miller & Julie Landry were on WKSK's Happy Time Show October 13th approximately 8 minutes to discuss their annual endowment Halloween party/dinner to benefit children in Ashe County. They shared details of the event and how folks could get involved. The Children's Trust Endowment is part of the Ashe County 4-H program in Ashe County.

<u>Children's Christmas Project:</u> Pastor Owen Peeler from Bethany United Methodist Church and David Blackburn with the Ashe Baptist Association were on WKSK's Happy Time Show October 17th to discuss the annual Christmas Agency Project in our county. They were on the show approximately 10 minutes discussing how the project provides for so many under privileged kids who don't receive anything at Christmas. They shared stories of Hope, and how folks in our community can get involved and make a difference.
