This report lists the news stories that aired on KNIN-TV during 2nd quarter 2018 that pertain to the six issues identified as of concern to the community:

Details follow:

ISSUE: ECONOMY

1. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 1, 2018 – 3 minutes of a 60 minute program

Economic boom and growth of the Treasure Valley has led to another Costco location in the community, and some community members are resisting.

2. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 29, 2018 – 2 minutes of a 60 minute program

A local booming economy has made the housing industry become so expensive that locals are getting priced out of buying new homes.

3. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – May 13, 2018 – 3 minutes of a 60 minute program

Californians coming to Idaho and buying property in the state has made it more difficult for local Idahoans to afford homes, likely leading to a big portion of the increased home prices.

4. 6 Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – May 27, 2018 – 2.5 minutes of a 60 minute program

Canyon County hosts a rivalry between Caldwell and Nampa, leaving both towns to compete to do better economically and attract business to their cities.

5. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – June 10, 2018 – 3.5 minutes of a 60 minute program

With a housing industry pushing costs to buy out of the range of locals, the cost to rent is also skyrocketing, making it difficult for those who can't afford to buy, as well.

ISSUE: TRANSPORTATION

1. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 1, 2018 – 30 seconds of a 60 minute program

Ada County Highway District asks the community members to send in details of potholes for road projects to be done in the future.

2. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 4, 2018 – 100 seconds of a 60 minute

Ada County Highway District has 91 projects active in the community with an irregularly busy road constructions season, led by a project on 36th St.

3. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – May 1, 2018 – 3 minutes of a 60 minute program

Transportation leaders are designating the month of May as a time to try mass transit, enabling people to ride for free during the month and figure out if it's right for them.

4. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – May 27, 2018 – 2 minutes of a 60 minute program

The end of May begins the traditional “100 most dangerous days of driving” on the roadways, when most accidents occur.

5. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – June 7, 2018 – 2 minutes of a 60 minute program

The Idaho Transportation Department is focused on widening the Interstate in a major project which could affect traffic on the highway for the next few years.

ISSUE: ENVIRONMENT

1. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 1, 2018 – 90 seconds of a 60 minute program

Irrigation season officially starts with officials releasing water into the canal system.

2. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 10, 2018 – 2 minutes of a 60 minute program

The Bureau of Land Management is conducting a massive effort to clean up the Snake River and get trash out of the waterways.

3. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 10, 2018 – 2 minutes of a 60 minute program

The Grizzly Bear was removed from federal protection, now local environmentalist groups are trying to stop glory killings, and some advocates for the hunting are looking forward to the opportunity.

4. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 10, 2018 – 2 minutes of a 60 minute program

The numbers of salmon in Idaho have gone down and there are some groups which are saying the reasons this is happening is partially because of dams along the waterways.

5. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – June 1, 2018 – 2 minutes of a 60 minute program

Mormon crickets have infested a small town in Idaho, putting a local festival at risk of not happening because of the increased number of bugs.

ISSUE: EDUCATION, HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICES

1. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 2, 2018 – 2 minutes of a 60 minute program

Administrators of a new medical school in Idaho gave media members a walk-through of the facility

2. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 22, 2018 – 3 minutes of a 60 minute program

A local school is encouraging its students to process and think about death, working through the meaning of life and what they want to do with their lives.

3. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – May 6, 2018 – 3.5 minutes of a 60 minute program

In the interest of safety, educators are working together to build new locks that keep doors closed and enable teachers to lock their doors during school shootings.

Educators are focused on finding a way for students to open up about their feelings, trying to curb the rising suicide numbers among teens.

The outgoing president of Boise State University wants to leave the campus in a better place than when he started. He sat down with Michelle Edmonds to reflect on his tenure.

ISSUE: GOVERNMENT & PUBLIC SAFETY

1. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm – April 2, 2018 – 2 minutes of a 60 minute program

More than 20 million dollars were designated for school safety improvements at schools across Idaho.

Boise is using a new system to sort plastics for recycling, creating added steps and frustration for individuals hoping to recycle.
