Thank you for your email expressing concern for the accuracy of the news stories on KJZY. I appreciate your interest, and take it seriously. It is my intention to be accurate and fair with the important issues of the day.

I use several sources for my new information. Even with major news providers I find discrepancies, which makes sorting out the truth even more of a challenge. As you can imagine, the political environment right now is especially vulnerable to the sways of the writers' own preferences, so I am trying to be careful to find the facts in what they write.

Here is the Associated Press piece I found this morning to base my story:

Newswire washington (AP) _ Former Attorney General Eric Holder is blasting FBI Director James Comey for divulging that the bureau has reopened its investigation of Hillary Clinton's emails. Holder writes in a Washington Post op-ed that Comey has unleashed ``a torrent of conspiracy theories and misrepresentations.'' Comey said information had turned up in an unrelated investigation of former Congressman Anthony Weiner, the estranged husband of Clinton aide Huma Abedin.

I trust AP for accuracy, however, I can see your point. It is a bit brief and could be interpreted a number of ways, but hopefully you see how I based my facts.

Again, thank you for taking the time to express your feelings. Please let me know whenever you have concerns.
