In an effort to broadcast responsive programming to address these issues, WPIE took the following action during the Second Broadcast Quarter.

WPIE aired an interview with Kelly Wade of Cayuga Lake National Bank, promoting a new initiative and partnership called the "Bee You Awards." During the last quarter, WPIE ascertained that youth and adult mental health and support is of major interest in our community.

In an effort to broadcast responsive programming to address these issues, WPIE took the following action during the Second Broadcast Quarter.

WPIE broadcast a segment on its local talk show, *Between the Lines*, promoting Dryden high school lacrosse's efforts to raise awareness on mental health. The team held its first "You Matter Game" to honor the memory of former Dryden lacrosse coach matt Williams, who passed away in 2022 after his own struggles with depression and mental health issues. The team used the game to bring awareness to a program within the school district called Mental Health 101: It Matters, which includes community resources, mental health services and social emotional learning opportunities.
