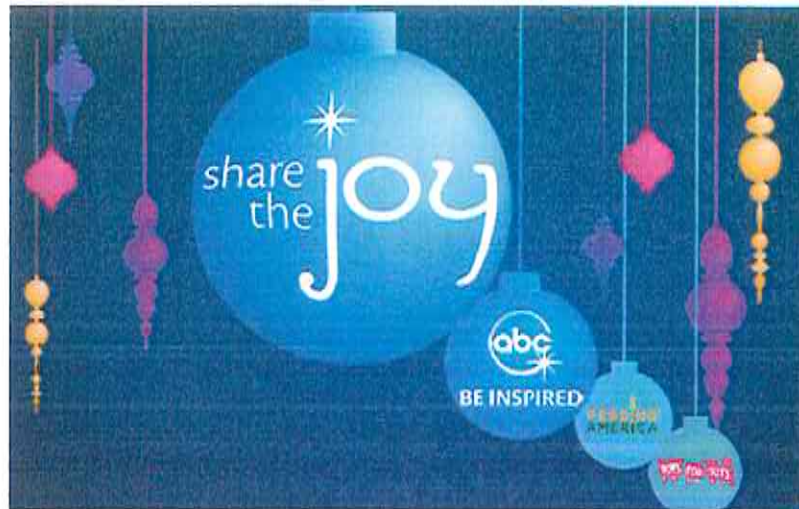

The hour features the heroes who helped one another through the horrific tragedy and a moment of crisis that was felt around the world.



Friday, October 13, 2017

#### **Allegations Against Harvey Weinstein**

"20/20" reports on the explosive allegations of sexual harassment and assault that have been made against powerful Hollywood mogul Harvey Weinstein. Friday night's report features interviews with multiple accusers about their encounters with the movie producer. Anchor Elizabeth Vargas reports.

Friday, October 20, 2017

#### **Killer Clown Cold Case**

A person dressed in a clown costume offering flowers and balloons shot Marlene Warren on the doorstep of her home. She died two days later – a shocking tragedy that paralyzed a well-to-do community in Palm Beach County where safety and security were taken for granted. Last month, police arrested Marlene's husband's new wife in a cold case nearly three decades old. "20/20" reports on the shocking story and new developments.

#### **27 Days Later: Mystery in Las Vegas**

Following the mass shooting at Las Vegas' Route 91 Harvest country music festival leaving 58 people dead and some 500 others injured, "20/20" investigates the unanswered questions that still remain. Correspondent Matt Gutman and chief investigative correspondent Brian Ross report.

#### **A Special Edition of 20/20: ISIS: Shifting Away From the Battlefield Overseas and Into American Homes**

ABC News Anchor Diane Sawyer and a team of producers investigated how ISIS targets young Americans online and recruiting them to join ISIS. Sawyer reports on who these young people are, what makes them vulnerable and why they want to become terrorists – is it for politics, religion or something else? The special edition of "20/20" features exclusives with teenage American recruits, former ISIS members and heartbroken parents who have had to turn in and track down their children. Sawyer goes inside the investigations with law enforcement to analyze surveillance video and tapes. She also reports on the efforts of technology companies to counter ISIS propaganda on social media and encrypted sites that flourish on the dark web.

Friday, November 10, 2017

#### **Coerced?**

"20/20" reports on young Olympic hopeful Baillie Gibson who alleges she was coerced into a three-year sexual relationship with her University of Arizona coach, Craig Carter. Carter claims the relationship was not only consensual, but that Baillie initiated it. "20/20" features the details about Carter's alleged threats of violence including text messages and a phone recording of his threats. Carter has countersued Baillie alleging defamation. Both sides deny the allegations. Deborah Roberts reports.

Friday, November 17, 2017

#### **"Wonder"**

It is every parent's fear during pregnancy – will my child be born healthy? Magda and Russel Newman had every reason to believe their child would be, but their son, Nathaniel Newman – now 13 – was born with a very rare cranio-facial condition called Treacher Collins Syndrome. Nathaniel was born with no cheekbones, ears, and almost no jawbone. In a complete coincidence, his life bears a striking resemblance to Auggie Pullman's, the fictional protagonist in R.J. Palacio's best-selling book, "Wonder." "20/20" follows Nathaniel as he comes to terms with his differences and his resilient family and prepare for future challenges.

Friday, November 24, 2017

#### **20/20: A Killing on the Cape**

Fifteen years after the murder, Christopher McCowen – who was convicted for her murder— speaks to "20/20" from jail in his first broadcast interview while he is fighting for freedom, claiming he is innocent. After a three-year investigation, police arrested McCowen, the local trash collector. He was eventually sentenced to life in prison without parole, but his trial raised questions about the evidence, investigative methods and whether racial prejudice played a role.

Friday, December 1, 2017

#### **Royal Engagement**

Days after the announcement of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle's engagement that has made worldwide headlines, "20/20" presents a primetime special on Meghan Markle's rise from American celebrity to member of the royal family, how the couple's romance blossomed, and what the future holds for Meghan and Harry, who may receive the titles of Duke and Duchess of Sussex when they marry. Markle, a California native best known as the character Rachel Zane on the TV show "Suits," will officially enter the royal family in a revolutionary way – as an American, a divorcée and an actress.

Friday, December 8, 2017

#### **Catfishing**

"20/20" speaks to the Canadian woman, Shelly Chartier, who almost ruined NBA star Chris "Birdman" Andersen's career and allegedly released nude photos of a young woman, as a result of her catfishing scheme. Chartier tells ABC News' Deborah Roberts what led her to start this scheme, how she feels towards her victims and what she is doing now after serving 12 months in prison. (OAD: 4/14/17)

Friday, December 15, 2017

#### **NXIVM Investigation**

"20/20" investigates NXIVM, a self-proclaimed professional coaching company, and speaks with former members who are now coming forward claiming that while they derived some benefit from NXIVM classes, the experience also took a big toll on their lives. According to its website, NXIVM claims to "provide the basis and conditions for all people to explore and actualize their potential so that they can come to live purposeful lives." Elizabeth Vargas reports.

#### **The Good Doctors: Brilliance and Bravery**

"20/20" Anchor Elizabeth Vargas sits down with doctors who have disabilities, are inspired by tragedy and practice improvised medicine, as they share their inspiring stories of resilience and survival. The special also goes behind-the-scenes on the set of "The Good Doctor" and interviews actor Freddie Highmore who stars in the show as Dr. Shaun Murphy, a surgical resident with autism and savant syndrome. Highmore discusses how he prepared for playing the role of a doctor with autism and how the public has responded to his role. (OAD: 9/13/17)

In 1994, Dee Dee drowned at the home of Los Angeles businessman Don Bohana. Although initially ruled as a swimming accident, the Jacksons disagreed and filed a wrongful death suit against Bohana. Two years later, the manner of death was officially changed to homicide, and Bohana was ultimately convicted of Dee Dee's murder.
