WNLS Radio Issues / Programs 3rd Quarter / 2022

During the previous quarter, the issues listed below have been significant to our community. We ran the responsive programming indicated to address them. This list is not exhaustive and the order does not reflect priority or significance.

ISSUE: Independence Day

RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: Feed the Multitudes PSAs

DATE / TIME: July 1 - July 3, 2022

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: Each Independence Day, Victory Church in Metairie hosts Feed the Multitudes. The free event provides food and entertainment, while meeting the physical and spiritual needs of the community, without charge. This year we aired thirty 30 second PSAs to promote the event, between June 17 - July 3, 2022, without charge.

ISSUE: Summer Boredom

RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: Vacation Bible School Calendar

DATE / TIME: July 1 - July 30, 2022

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: School is out for summer, which can mean summer boredom for kiddos! We invited local churches to post their Vacation Bible School events on our Vacation Bible School calendar. We made the calendar available to our listeners on our website, so they could find a Vacation Bible School in their area.

ISSUE: Students in need of school supplies

RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: Back to School Promotion

DATE / TIME: July 2 - August 2, 2022

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: We teamed up with Infinite Blessings and Send Relief to provide children with much needed school supplies for the upcoming school year. We invited our listeners, who could, to donate school supplies. And we invited our listeners in
