Jeff Chang, the FCC license of digital television station KQSL, (Facility 8378) certifies that, during the period between July 1, 2017-September 30, 2017, KQSL aired children's programming in compliance with the Children's Television Act of 1990, and with the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission. Those rules and regulations limit the total amount of commercial matter in programs produced and broadcast primarily for children 12 years of age and under to 10.5 minutes per hour or less on weekends, and 12 minutes per hour or less on weekdays.

During the quarter, there were no occasions on which the commercial limits were exceeded, as all of children's programming during the quarter did not contain any commercial breaks or commercial content. Moreover, certain children's programs broadcast on KQSL are for ages 13-16 years old, therefore not subject to advertising limits. And, further, all children's program broadcast on KQSL during the quarter also complied with the Commission's restrictions on the appearance of commercial Internet web site addresses.
