1ST QUARTER 2010 PROGRAMS AND ISSUES FOR KCDO-TV 4/5/2010

-From 1/1/10-3/31/10 M-F 10-1034pm KCDO-TV aired Northern Colorado 5 News. This Northern Colorado focused local newscast aired 63 times in 1st quarter 2010 and included many stories and topics of interest to the Ft. Collins, Greeley, Fort Morgan and Sterling area. This is the only newscast in Colorado that focuses on this region with local news, weather, business and sports specific to the region. Among the issues covered for this quarter were: unemployment, farming techniques and real estate prices, water rights and potential shortages, health care, new employment opportunities through businesses relocating to the region, political issues and candidates for offices affecting the region, immigration and law enforcement.

-KCDO-TV aired 130 Public Service Announcements during the first quarter of 2010. These were a combination of local and national PSA's provided to the station.

-KCDO-TV also aired 800 Digital Education crawls alerting viewers to the station's transition to full power digital broadcasting that commenced on 1/25/2010.

6/6/10 The Aaron Harber Show Sunday's 8-830pm: This locally produced program featured a 26 minute exclusive interview with General Colin Powell and focused on the meaning of leadership.

6/6/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday's 830-9pm: This locally produced non-partisan political oriented program featured a 26 minute interview with Republican candidate for Governor Dan Maes. This candidate's positions on all issues related to potentially governing the state were discussed and explored.

6/13/10 The Aaron Harber Show Sunday's 8-830pm: John Holdren, President Obama's top Science Adviser was interviewed for 26 minutes and discussed the role of Science in setting Public Policy. Global climate change and its potential causes and effects related to this region and globally were discussed in detail.

6/20/10 The Aaron Harber Show Sunday's 8-830pm: Former Federal Reserve Vice-Chairman Alan Binder discussed the US Economy in this 26 minute interview. Local impact of the nation's economic trends was also discussed.

6/20/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday's 830-9pm: Part 1 of the debate between the Republican and Democratic candidates for the Attorney General's office for Colorado. KCDO-TV is the only broadcast station airing this debate in the Denver DMA. The state's water rights, protection of its citizens and overall philosophy in running this office was debated by both parties with moderator Aaron Harber. Part 2 aired in the same time period on Sunday, June 27th.

4/1/10 - 6/30/10 Northern Colorado 5 News at 10pm weekdays: This Northern Colorado focused local newscast aired 65 times in 2^{nd} quarter 2010 and included many stories and issues of interest to the Ft. Collins, Greeley, Fort Morgan and Sterling area. This is the only newscast in Colorado that focuses on this region with local news, weather, business and sports specific to the region. Among the issues covered for this quarter were unemployment, farming/ranching related topics, local area real estate sales and housing prices and availability, health care, water rights, political issues and candidates affecting the region, immigration and law enforcement.

4/1/10-6/30/10: 609 PSA's were aired during the quarter for the following topics: Underage drinking prevention, Teen suicide prevention, American Association of Orthodontists, Diabetes Foundation, American Quarter Horse Association, local Animal Shelter, Colorado National Guard, Long Term Care and Big Brothers/Big Sisters.

In June 2010 KCDO-TV aired 75 PSA's promoting the High Plains Outdoor Expo and Tractor Pull 6/19 & 6/20 sponsored by the Logan County Chamber of Commerce. KCDO-TV also participated as a promotional sponsor for the High Plains Music Festival in Sterling in June and aired PSA's for this event that raised \$800 for local school band programs in Logan County.

7/4/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. This weekly program is a locally produced non-partisan political show that highlights candidates and issues of importance to Colorado. On this day Part 3 of the debate between the Republican and Democratic candidates for the Attorney General of Colorado aired. Moderator Aaron Harber, Republican candidate John Suthers and Democratic candidate Stan Garnett discussed their respective positions and qualifications for this statewide office.

7/11/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Part 1 of the debate between candidates for the Republican Treasurer primary election for the state of Colorado. Moderated by Aaron Harber, J.J. Ament and Walker Stapleton voiced their qualifications for this office and the policies they would support.

7/18/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Part 2 of the above debate.

7/25/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Host Aaron Harber interviewed current Democratic Colorado Treasurer Cary Kennedy regarding his record, qualifications and positions in order to provide viewers with an in depth assessment of this candidate.

8/1/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Aaron Harber interviewed current Colorado Lieutenant Governor Barbara O'Brien (D) as to why Colorado voters should retain her for office in the upcoming general election.

8/8/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Aaron Harber interviewed Republican Senate candidate Jane Norton as to her qualifications for this office and why voters in Colorado should support her primary campaign.

8/29/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Part 1 of the debate between the candidates running for the office of Secretary of State for Colorado. Aaron Harber moderated the debate between Bernie Buescher (D) and Scott Gessler (R).

9/5/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Part 2 of the above debate aired.

9/12/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Aaron Harber's exclusive interview with Tom Tancredo to discuss his motivation for a 3rd party run for Governor of the state of Colorado and to determine his qualifications and platform for that office.

9/19/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Aaron continues a further in depth exploration of the Governor's race with this interview with Republican candidate for Governor Dan Maes.

9/27/10 Colorado Election 2010 Sunday 830-9pm. Democratic Governor John Hickenlooper is the 3rd and final interview done by Aaron Harber and once again an in depth non partisan Q & A occurs where the current mayor of Denver outlines his positions and qualifications for Governor of Colorado.

7/1/10-9/30/10 Northern Colorado News 5 at 10pm airs weekdays. This Northern Colorado focused local newscast aired 66 times in 3rd quarter 2010 and included many stories of interest to the Ft. Collins, Greeley, Fort Morgan and Sterling area. This is the only local newscast in Colorado that focuses on this region with local news, weather, business and sports specific to the region. Among the issues covered this quarter were forest fires affecting the area, political candidates and issues relevant to the region, unemployment, real estate, health care, law enforcement, economic reviews and projections, immigration and a host of other issues and news relative to the region.

During the 3rd Quarter of 2010 KCDO-TV aired 3,251 Public Service Announcements. Here are the topics and organizations that aired: Know Your Judge, Senior Companion, Take Root Denver, American Orthodontists Association, Men's Health, Teen suicide Prevention, Colorado National Guard, Quarter Horse Health, Underage Drinking Prevention and Diabetes education & prevention.

10/3/10 From 8-830pm on this date KCDO-TV continued the Colorado Election 2010 series. The locally produced program is the only one in the Denver DMA targeted to the pending election and the candidates and issues affecting Coloradoans. KCDO-TV is the only Denver DMA TV station airing a weekly series on local political races and issues. Tonight's guest is Democratic Governor candidate John Hickenlooper and host Aaron Harber provides an in-depth interview on this candidate's platform and vision for Colorado if elected. Another Episode of Colorado Election 2010 aired 830-9pm and this featured Aaron Harber interviewing both Cary Kennedy and Walker Stapleton, Democrat & Republican respectively, who are running for Colorado State Treasurer. This debate style format revealed and discussed each candidate's positions should they be elected.

10/10/10 Two episodes of Colorado Election 2010 aired from 8-9pm. The first (8-830pm) was a debate between proponents and opponents of the Healthcare Amendment which is asking Colorado voters whether they want to oppose the recently enacted National Health Care Plan. The second show (830-9pm) was a debate on the Personhood Amendment on the ballot that defines when life begins in a fetus. Representatives of both positions debated on this issue. Aaron Harber was moderator of both programs.

10/17/10 Colorado Election 2010 from 8-830pm featured Aaron Harber interviewing the Republican Congressional candidates for Colorado Districts 4 and 7. Cory Gardner and Ryan Frazier outlined their respective positions and why they feel they should be elected. Cory Gardner is from the District where KCDO-TV is licensed and resides in Yuma, CO. The Democratic incumbents were invited but did not attend. From 830-9pm Colorado Election 2010 had a debate between Congressional District 6 candidates Mike Coffman (R) and John Flerlage (D) again hosted by Aaron Harber.

10/24/10 Colorado Election 2010 from 8-9pm consisted of a debate on the Tax Measures to be voted on the upcoming ballot. Amendments 60, 61 and Proposition 101 had representatives taking both pro and con positions on these complex taxation issues. Aaron Harber served as moderator and this event was taped live before an audience at Denver University and then aired tonight.

10/31/10 Colorado Election 2010 aired from 8-10pm with a first in Colorado political history. KCDO-TV invited candidates to have a long form opportunity, on the eve of the election, to outline their final positions to voters and explain why they should receive viewers votes. Following are the candidates who accepted the invitation to appear with interviewer Aaron Harber: Jared Polis, Stephen Bailey, Stan

Garnett, Mike Coffman, John Flerlage, Tom Tancredo, Scott Tipton, Diana DeGette, Mike Fallon, Dan Maes, Ken Buck, Scott Gessler and Bernie Buescher.

11/7/10 The Aaron Harber Show Sunday's 8-830pm. World renowned artists Christo and Jeanne-Claude discuss their attempted project to drape the Colorado River and the potential environmental and business impact associated with this controversial artistic undertaking.

11/21/10 The Aaron Harber show 8-830pm. Aaron interviews retired Supreme Court Justice Sandra Day O'Connor to gain her insights into legal and political policy affecting Colorado and other Western states.
