ONLY TWO MONTHS AWAY FROM THE WORLD CUP, THE BRAZILIAN GOVERNMENT SENT THOUSANDS OF SOLDIERS TO SALVADOR AND NEARBY CITIES IN AN ATTEMPT TO REDUCE A WAVE OF VIOLENCE. TRANSLATION: TYPE 2 DIABETES DETERIORATES THE BRAIN ACCORDING TO A STUDY FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA. EXPERTS STUDIED IMAGES OF MAGNETIC RESONANCE OF HUNDREDS OF DIABETICS AND FOUND THAT THOSE WHO HAD SUFFERED THE ILLNESS FOR LONGER PERIODS OF TIME HAD LESS GRAY MATTER IN THEIR BRAIN. AS A RESULT, THEIR MEMORY, EMOTIONS AND SELF-CONTROL COULD BE AFFECTED.
