ISSUE:

How can you prevent the spread of food-borne illness?

Discussion of Issue:

Food safety is an ongoing issue in the community. Citizens need to be reminded of the dangers of cross-contamination, especially during the summer months. Food left out for long periods of time or foods prepared incorrectly can lead to serious illnesses.

Programming: KTSC-FM addressed this issue through several different kinds of programs, including public affairs discussions, news stories, and PSA'S. The following are illustrative examples of such programming:

a. T-Wolf Talk 04/07/15 8:00 a.m. – 8:25 a.m. Pueblo City-County Health Department Inspectors discussed food safety issue and their show, "The Dish." They explained proper procedures for preparing and storing food, as

well as ways to prevent cross contamination and the spread of foodborne illnesses.

c. News Programming
