## **READ ENTIRE PAGE**

On September 24<sup>th</sup>, 1998, the television stations of Oregon Public Broadcasting (KOPB-TV, KOAC-TV, KTVR, KOAB-TV, and KEPB-TV) were granted licenses by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as public trustees until February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007.

Our licenses for these stations will expire on February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007. We must file applications for license renewal with the FCC on or before October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2006. When filed, copies of the applications will be available for public inspection during our regular business hours. Our public files contain information concerning each station's performance during the last license term.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to any of these renewal applications and to whether a station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the FCC no later than January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007.
