WALV-CD programmed the “MeTV Network” on its main channel (46.1). MeTV programs classic television series and classic movies. A simulcast of WTHR 13 Sunrise runs M-F 4am-5am and a simulcast of WTHR 13 Sunrise runs Sa-Su 6am-7am on WALV-CD (46.1) throughout the entire quarter. The remaining sub-channels of WALV-CD, broadcast as follows: This TV (46.2), Shop LC (46.3), TheGrio (46.4), QVC2 (46.5), Heroes & Icons (46.6). Shop LC is an online shopping channel, ThisTV and TheGrio primarily feature classic movies along with limited episodes of classic tv series, QVC2 features exclusive live shows and other content not seen on QVC, and Heroes & Icons, focuses on action/adventure, westerns, crime dramas, sci-fi and superhero shows.

Each program regularly provides information or addresses current local issues of concern to viewers in the area where the station is located.
