NATIONAL The Los Angeles Police Department has cleared a possible bomb sent to Congresswoman Maxine Waters. The package was found at an LA mail sorting center, which had to be evacuated.

MICHIGAN City officials are issuing a water system advisory for Benton Harbor. According to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, water samples were collected from 30 homes this summer, eight of which came back with high lead levels.

FLINT Flint City Council is subpoenaing the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality. The decision to subpoena was made at a Oct. 24 Flint City Council hearing held to understand how state funds are flowing into and out of the city.

NATIONAL The Camp Fire continues to char Northern California and has now claimed 29 lives. In a news conference Sunday, Butte County Sheriff Kory Honea said six additional bodies were found Sunday in Paradise, California.

MICHIGAN Renovation work on the Michigan Central Train Station will begin before the end of the year. Ford Motor Company purchased the historic building in Detroit's Corktown area earlier this year for 90-million dollars.

DETROIT More Detroit residents went to work in September than any point this decade, according to data from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. Nearly 2,500 more Detroiters were employed in September than in August.

NATIONAL A massive snow storm in the Southeast is leaving thousands of people without power. Certain heavy hit areas received up to two feet of snow. More than 327-thousand homes and businesses across six states lost power.

MICHIGAN After several weeks of decline, gasoline prices in Michigan are higher. According to Triple-A Michigan, the average price of regular unleaded is six-cents higher statewide than one week ago at two-dollars-34-cents a gallon.
