INTRODUCTION

This program report reflects the second quarter activity from WJR (AM) radio of Detroit, Michigan ("WJR").

From April 1st through June 30th, 2014 WJR broadcast a variety of programming that centered on our community and public affairs.

WJR broadcasts local news at the top and bottom of almost every hour Monday through Sunday. Newscasts are between 3 and 13 minutes in duration. Public Service Announcements run on average 10 – 15 times daily on the station. PSAs average 0:30-0:60 seconds. In this quarter, WJR ran various PSAs for a total of 2,014 PSAs broadcast announcements.

The issues determined by WJR to be of concern to members of our community of license in this quarter included: Elections, Events and Activities, City of Detroit, Legislature and Sports.

The following pages describe some of the station's most significant treatment of the issues of concern described above from April through June 2014. The shows detailed below include:

"The Paul W. Smith Morning Show" airing from 5:35 am – 9 am Monday through Friday. Paul concentrates the big stories of the day in short segments.

"The Frank Beckmann Show" airing 9 – Noon Monday – Friday. Frank discusses current issues with more depth and coverage.

"The Mitch Albom Show" airing 5-7 pm Monday – Friday. Mitch discusses current issues and does open line getting listeners opinions.

"The Big Story" with WJR News Anchor Lloyd Jackson airing on various dates Monday.- Friday from 7-8 pm. The biggest stories of the day plus the best Interviews from The Paul W. Smith Morning Show and Frank Beckmann Show.

"The Warren Pierce Show" that airs Saturdays 5am-9am and Sundays from 6am-8am covers current topics in short segments.
