Full Sail Career Fair February 9, 2023

The Employment Unit participated in the career fair, Jessica Pacheco, Assistant News Director & Abel Aluart, Production Director of WTVJ participated to identify candidates that are recently graduating from college with degrees in entertainment, media, arts, and technology.

El Poder en Ti Educational Campaign – May 2, 2023 through October 28, 2023 – The

Employment Unit has created a multiplatform campaign “El Poder en Ti” designed to educate the community about the federal financial assistance program known as FAFSA, available for students who wish to pursue higher education through college, university, or vocational school. The initiative was the first of its kind in the Orlando Market. The idea was born from a need of knowing how to navigate the education system amongst Hispanics. Currently, Florida ranks 48th out of the 50 states for its FAFSA completion rate, leaving millions of dollars in Pell Grants on the table every year.

We have done a series of vignettes featuring financial aid counselors, students and parents to empower those interested in starting a career to apply for FAFSA. We aired stories every Tuesday at 6 pm to explain in depth the process of how it works, while highlighting successful stories of students all across Central Florida. Due to the gap we still found after some surveys on social media, we decided to do a phone bank on one of the Tuesdays with seven local experts on financial aid who represented all of our counties. They answered questions about financial assistance in Spanish and English, including FAFSA alternatives. We promoted it via social media with the use of reels, promos and throughout the newscasts a week before. We received over 100 calls and shared the results via Instagram in a bilingual reel since our goal is to attract second and third generation hispanics as well.

The stories that followed the phone bank were tailored to address the most common questions we received. All the stories can be found in our web page along with an interactive video using YouTube under “El Poder en Ti,” the slogan of our campaign.

Clear the Shelters August 1 through August 31, 2023

The Employment Unit teamed up with more than 15 local shelters to promote pet adoption in this yearly pet adoption event. Acceso Total talent, Michelle Feliz, conducted interviews with new pet parents.

Voter Registration Phone Bank with Hispanic Federation September 19, 2023

The Employment Unit joins forces with the Hispanic Federation by opening up the lines to the Hispanic community in Florida to answer questions and provide information of available resources due to voter registration rights and processes.
