Pursuant to a license granted by the FCC permitting experimental operation by KORS-CD, KOXI-CD, KKEI-CD, and KORK-CD, allowing signals to be transmitted in the ATSC 3.0 format, the local programming of these stations was transmitted on KOXO-CD, Channel 41, in the ATSC 1.0 format rather than their respective channels. Pursuant to conditions of granted experimental license, hours of operation and transmitted power levels may vary to allow specific tests to be conducted in the ATSC 3.0 format on stations KOXI-CD, KKEI-CD, KORK-CD, and KORS-CD.

KOXO-CD was silent from February 4 to February 10, 2018 due to loss of STL connectivity from studio to transmitter site. At times during this outage a color bar signal and station ID were displayed. Network signals were fully restored on February 10, 2018.
