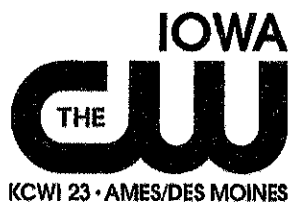

Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity/Founder's Day of Caring

CW Iowa 23 and our sister station Local 5 celebrated the anniversary of our parent company's (Nexstar Media Group) founding, by volunteering in a Founder's Day of Caring on Friday, June 14th (company anniversary is June 17th).

Many staff members participated in and broadcast live from the event. Again, this year, station staff worked on a new construction home in Des Moines as part of Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity's continued efforts in the Birdland neighborhood.
