The following are summary descriptions of the issues aired by this station.

Issue: Building Strong Families

Summary: Our community has significant numbers of unwed pregnancies and a number of abortions every year, signs that many members of our community do not understand the significance of these issues. Programming addressing pregnancy and abortion is designed to better inform listeners regarding these issues.

Issue: Education for Careers

Summary: Our community needs to have attention focused on completion of high school, college and technical education to provide our citizens the tools they need to contribute to the well-being of their personal lives, families and community. Programming is aired to encourage students to remain in school and continue their education.

Issue: Financial Literacy

Summary: Americans ages 25-34, including those in our area, have financial behaviors that tend toward debt accumulation, and this is happening during a period of milestone events such as getting married, having children and caring for aging parents. But there is hope: more working time before retirement means that their current financial decisions have a greater impact (positive or negative) on their long term financial security.
