This is a list of some of the significant issues responded to by the programming of **KRLT FM**, South Lake Tahoe, California, for the period of **April 1**<sup>st</sup> **2023**, **to June 30**<sup>th</sup> **2023**. This list does not reflect priority of significance, nor does it include all of the issues that were aired by **KRLT FM**. Prepared by Steve Harness and uploaded to the public file on **July 10**<sup>th</sup> **2023**.

The following announcements were run addressing a variety of issues and concerns based on community interests such as crime, quality of life, community involvement, community development, and the environment. Announcements were read live by the on-air staff or were pre-taped and played back during regular programming:

- 1. Tahoe Visitors Authority for the "2023 Lights on the Lake Fireworks" show. This is a free community event for a fireworks show on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. We provide the music for the show and remind the community that personal fireworks are illegal and dangerous in the Lake Tahoe Basin. :60 second PSA 5-15-23 to 6-30-23. This was read live at least 150 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 2. The Clean Tahoe Program announcements for their "community cleanup day" event where locals can dump large amounts of trash at the refuse center for one flat discounted rate. There is also free e-waste disposal offered on the day of the event which was June 10<sup>th</sup> 2023. :30 second PSA 5-15-23 to 6-10-23. This was read live at least 20 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 3. Pet Network of Northern Nevada Every Thursday morning at 8:30am a representative comes in with a dog or cat that needs to be adopted from her non-profit animal shelter. This is a 5 minute live interview with the on air talent in which she discusses the organization in general and how to adopt animals from them.
- 4. Casey's American Cantina non-profit fundraiser for the "Ukrainian Red Cross". A night of food specials and live music with the proceeds going to war relief efforts of Red Cross in Ukraine. :30 second PSA 5-01-23 to 6-15-23. This was read live at least 40 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 5. South Lake Tahoe Fire Department announcements were read reminding people that all fireworks are illegal in the basin as we approach the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday weekend. :60 second PSA 6-01-23 to 6-30-23. This was read live at least 60 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 6. Gamblers Anonymous reminders about the program and when local meetings are. :60 second PSA 4-01-23 to 6-30-23. This was read live at least 10 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.

- 7. The Selective Service Systems announcements reminding all men to register within 30 days of their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. :60 second PSA 4-1-23 to 6-1-23. This was read live at least 4 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 8. American Legion Post 795 announcements for their Memorial Day services at the happy homestead cemetery where the community can gather to honor our local fallen veterans. :60 second PSA 5-1-23 to 5-29-23. This was read live at least 30 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 9. South Lake Tahoe Fire department Monthly PSA's that are pre-taped and gear towards a seasonal fire safety tip. These are voiced by Sally from the SLT Fire Dept. At least 3 different versions run each month. :30 second PSA's 4-01-23 to 6-30-23. These each aired at least 15 times in total from the hours of 12am to 12am Monday through Sunday.
- 10. St. Joseph Community Land Trust. announcements for this non-profit group that buy land parcels and leases them back to local families at a discounted rate. The idea is to provide affordable housing for Tahoe locals and not for tourists.:30 second PSA 4-1-23 to 6-30-23. This was aired at least 75 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 11. Grocery Outlet announcements for their food kitchen benefit efforts to stock local food banks with donations throughout the month of July. PSA 6-1-23 to 6-30-23. This was read live at least 65 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 12. The Clean Tahoe Program announcements for their "beach cleanup day" event where people can help clean our beaches after the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday. :30 second PSA 5-1-23 to 6-30-23. This was read live at least 50 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.

- \* Incline Village Library calendar of events for April 2023. :60 second PSA 4-1-23 to 4-29-23. This was read live at least 3 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- \* Incline Village Library calendar of events for May 2023. :60 second PSA 5-1-23 to 5-29-23. This was read live at least 3 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- \* Incline Village Library calendar of events for June 2023. :60 second PSA 6-1-23 to 6-29-23. This was read live at least 3 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- \* US Forest Service's announcements informing locals that several area parks & trails will opening on-time this season. :60 second PSA 5-1-23 to 6-15-23. This was read live at least 10 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
