This is a list of some of the significant issues responded to by the programming of **KRLT FM**, South Lake Tahoe, California, for the period of **January 1st 2019, to March 31st 2019**. This list does not reflect priority of significance, nor does it include all of the issues that were aired by **KRLT FM**. Prepared by Steve Harness and uploaded the public file on **April 10th 2019**.

The following announcements were run addressing a variety of issues and concerns based on community interests such as crime, quality of life, community involvement, community development, and the environment. Announcements were read live by the on air staff or were pre-taped and played back during regular programming:

1. Pet Network of Northern Nevada – Every Thursday morning at 8:30am Caleb Knapp comes in with a dog or cat that needs to be adopted from her non-profit animal shelter. This is a 5 minute live interview with the on air talent in which she discusses the organization in general and how to adopt animals from them.
2. Sierra Child & Family Services - :60 second PSA 1-01-19 to 3-30-19. This was read live at least 10 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
3. Kiwanis Club of Tahoe Sierra – Crab-fest fund raising event. featuring food, drinks, entertainment, silent auctions and more. Funds raised go to help under privileged children in the community. :60 second PSA 2-1-19 to 3-10-19. This was read live at least 15 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday
4. St Baldrick's – This fund raiser features people shaving their heads to raise money for the Northern Nevada Children's Cancer research center.. It was March 5th at the rec center in SLT. :60 second PSA 2-1-19 to 3-5-19. This was read live at least 45 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
5. The Sierra House Elementary School “Weather Kids” – Every Monday- Friday we have a local school child from the advanced science class at the “Sierra House Elementary School” phone in or come into the studio to read the weather (as compiled by them) live on the radio. This is a 5 minute segment M-F @ 8:20am
6. US Forest Service Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit looking for skiers or snowboarders to volunteer as guides for tours at Heavenly. :60 second PSA 1-1-19 to 2-15-19. This was read live at least 15 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
7. CASA of El Dorado – signing up new volunteers for a 4 week training course. CASA member help youth through the court system.:60 second PSA 3-1-19 to 3-30-19. This

was read live at least 15 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.

8. The El Dorado County Library – The Annual book sale where the library sells old movies, DVD's, software, etc to raise money for the “kids programs” there. :60 second PSA 2-1-19 to 2-10-19. This was read live at least 10 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
9. South Lake Tahoe Fire department – Monthly PSA's that are pretaped and gear towards a seasonal fire safety tip. These are voiced by Sally from the SLT Fire Dept. At least 3 different versions run each month. :30 second PSA's 1-01-19 to 3-31-19. These each aired at least 5 times in total from the hours of 12am to 12am Monday through Sunday.
10. Gamblers Anonymous – reminders about the program and when local meetings are. :60 second PSA 1-01-19 to 3-30-19. This was read live at least 10 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
11. South Lake Tahoe Chamber – Every Wednesday morning at 8:40am the Chamber of Commerce comes on for a live interview to discuss programs available to local businesses. :60 second PSA 1-1-19 to 3-30-19. This is a live interview an averages 15 minutes in length.
12. Polar Plunge event – This annual event raises money for the Special Olympics of Northern Nevada. Local teams are sponsored to raise money and must take a “polar plunge” into Lake Tahoe. In addition to that, we promoted all teams involved and the event in general with :60 second PSA's 3-01-19 to 3-23-19. This was read live at least 40 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.

Announcements were also run for the following agencies:

* Tahoe Douglas Rotary Club – St Patrick's Day fund raising event. Community members are invited to celebrate and learn more about the local rotary club. This event was held at Harrah's convention center on March 12th 2019. :60 second PSA 2-15-19 to 3-10-19. This was read live at least 25 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.

* Lake Tahoe South Shore Chamber of Commerce – Monthly mixers and new member announcements. :60 second PSA 1-1-19 to 1-31-19. This was read live at least 3 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.

* Incline Village Library – calendar of events for January 2019. :60 second PSA 1-1-19 to 1-29-19. This was read live at least 3 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.

* Incline Village Library – calendar of events for February 2019. :60 second PSA 1-1-19 to 1-28-19. This was read live at least 3 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
