This is a list of some of the significant issues responded to by the programming of **KRLT FM**, South Lake Tahoe, California, for the period of **July 1st 2015**, **to September 30th 2015**. This list does not reflect priority of significance, nor does it include all of the issues that were aired by **KRLT FM**. Prepared by Steve Harness and put in the public file on **October 4th 2015**.

The following announcements were run addressing a variety of issues and concerns based on community interests such as crime, quality of life, community involvement, community development, and the environment. Announcements were read live by the on air staff or were pre-taped and played back during regular programming:

- 1. US Forest Service 4th of July community event at Taylor Creek highlighting invasive species and forest fire safety. :60 second PSA 7-1-15 to 7-4-15. This was read live at least 30 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday. We also broadcast live for 3 hours on July 4th from 11am 2pm at the event. We did a total of 9 call-ins at 90 seconds each.
- 2. Live Violence Free The "Sunset Gala" is the largest annual fund raising event for this local sexual assault & domestic violence crisis center. KRLT / KOWL were media sponsors :60 second PSA 8-15-15 to 9-27-15. This was read live at least 75 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 3. US Forest Service Fall Fish Festival at the Taylor Creek Visitors Center. Annual fundraising and community involvement event focusing on the once a year event of the kokanee salmon spawning in a local river.. :60 second PSA 9-1-15 to 9-30-15. This was read live at least 30 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 4. South Lake Tahoe Fire Dept. announcements for "vehicles needed for training practices". Citizens were asked to donate broken down vehicles for county wide training drills. :60 second PSA 8-1-15 to 9-1-15. This was read live at least 14 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 5. Pet Network of Northern Nevada Weekly PSA announcements to remind people about their adoption services and the fact that they don't euthanize. :60 second PSA 7-01-15 to 8-30-15. This was read live at least 10 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday per month.
- 6. LTBMU reminding everyone that dogs are not allowed on the public beaches in the summer. :60 second PSA 7-01-15 to 8-30-15. This was read live at least 10 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.

- 7. Boys and Girls Club 22nd annual golf tournament at Edgewood. Entry fee goes to the boys and girls club, prizes are offered up for the top finishers. :60 second PSA 8-01-15 to 9-15-15. This was read live at least 35 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 8. Tahoe Douglas Visitors Authority Fireworks cleanup PSA's. Announcements for public beach cleanup days after our annual 4th of July fireworks show. Volunteers are need to clean up debris and trash. :60 second PSA 7-5-15 to 8-1-15. This was read live at least 45 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 9. American Legion Post 795 Patriot Days celebration on 9-11-15 at the American Legion Hall at 2748 Lake Tahoe blvd. Snacks & Coffee after. :60 second PSA 8-1-15 to 9-11-15. This was read live at least 55 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 10. South Tahoe Wooden Boat Classic An annual fundraising event for local charities sponsored by Raley's. This is a free community event with an emphasis on boating safety. :60 second PSA 7-01-15 to 7-30-15. This was read live at least 20 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- 11. South Lake Tahoe Fire department Monthly PSA's that are pretaped and gear towards a seasonal fire safety tip. These are voiced by Sally from the SLT Fire Dept. At least 3 different versions run each month. :30 second PSA's 7-01-15 to 9-30-15. These each aired at least 5 times in total from the hours of 12am to 12am Monday through Sunday.
- 12. Tahoe Chamber Every Wednesday morning at 8:40am the Tahoe Chamber comes on for a live interview to discuss programs available to local businesses. :60 second PSA 7-1-15 to 9-30-15. This is a live interview an averages 15 minutes in length.

Funds raised go to help under privileged children in the community. :60 second PSA 9-1-15 to 9-15-15. This was read live at least 25 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- * El Dorado Animal Shelter reminder of hours and operations. 530-577-1766. :60 second PSA 7-01-15 to 9-01-15. This was read live at least 5 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
- * Tahoe Art League Summer Artist Studio Tour This non-profit group hosts an annual tour of local artist studios for free. Art education and techniques are a primary focus. :60 second PSA 7-01-15 to 7-20-15. This was read live at least 10 times in total from the hours of 6am to 6pm Monday through Friday.
