Section I. Issues

The above stations have identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. Environment & Waste: Out of the three major cities in the area, Pasco is the only city that doesn't have a mandatory recycling program in place for residents. This means recyclables are mixed in with regular trash putting plastics and aluminum into landfills. The stations discussed the impact plastics have on the environment and why it is important to cut back on use of plastic.
- **B.** Immigration Reform: Like many cities around the country, the Tri-Cities is experiencing an influx of migrants seeking asylum. The stations covered how this influx is leading to chaos and frustration among residents and city leaders.
- C. Mental Health: The cold dark days during the winter months in Tri-Cities are a major reason for seasonal depression. This, coupled with the lasting impacts of the pandemic, has many residents suffering from depression and loneliness. The stations discussed how residents can make connections with self-help organizations, health professionals and even neighbors, which will help combat the feelings of dread.
- D. Affordable Childcare: With the rising population in the area, the need for affordable childcare has become a major issue. The cost of childcare has forced many to use other alternatives and family to watch children. The stations presented the day-to-day impact the rising costs have had on parents and what needs to be changed to better support families.
- **E. Scams/Public Safety:** Last year, Americans lost nearly nine billion dollars to scams. As the holiday season approached, a time when scams increase, the stations presented information on the fastest growing frauds and why so many people are getting tricked.
