

"One nation, One Number, The 811 Program, it provides Columbia gas of PA and all the other gas companies and power companies and cable companies, "the facility owners," calling 811 gives everyone a chance to mark their lines with colored paint, flags or chalk and prevent a potentially dangerous situation. "Know What's Below." PA One Call's Call Before You Dig Hotline operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Its convenient, its free and it's the law. Even if you're planning on planting shrubs or building a deck or even installing a mailbox, they ALL require a call to 811.


**SUBJECTS AND/OR TOPICS COVERED:**

In his honor and memory, musician friends of Sonny put together an event to benefit Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh. That inaugural event gradually expanded into a yearly all-star concert to benefit again, The Music Smiles Program, Live Music In Caring Places. The Sonny Pugar Memorial Foundation pays local musicians to perform live in local hospitals. The Rhythms of Life Concert every October is the Foundation's signature fundraising event.


### **SUBJECTS AND/OR TOPICS COVERED:**

MHY offers a therapeutic campus environment, individualized education programs and community services where learning and healing occur for youth and families. Youth and families have the opportunity to learn skills that help them manage and cope with trauma-based issues and to re-engage with home, school and community. MHY began as the United Presbyterians Orphans Home on Pittsburgh's North Side serving families who, as a result of death or poverty, could no longer care for their children. In 1929 an estate in Butler was purchased where MHY Family Services stands today. MHY stands for, by the way, Mars Home for Youth. MHY Family Services mission is to promote the safety, health, education and spiritual well being of youth and families. At MHY, intensive individual therapy and family therapy is complemented by psychiatric treatment for young boys and girls dealing with chronic and persistent emotional and behavioral problems.


**SUBJECTS AND/OR TOPICS COVERED:**

Chico Ficerai and her husband Joe started their own ministry, "Six Steps To Sanity" in order to help parents, grandparents and other family members affected by a heroin/opioid addicted family member. Addiction impacts the entire family. Chico and Joe Fiscerai realized their teenage son was a heroin addict. While they found help for him they did NOT find help for themselves. Who could they talk to about this, who else would understand, was it something they as parents failed to do, were they as parents partly to blame for their teenaged son's addiction? "Six Steps To Sanity" was founded as a support group for families dealing with an addicted family member, and the ministry is based on the book by "Setting Boundries with Your Adult Children," by Allison Bottke. A heroin/opioid addicted teenager is a reality for tens of thousands of families across the country. Yet many parents probably don't realize that they themselves have at least partial responsibility for their child's addiction, and their best intentions may in fact be hurting their addicted child.


**SUBJECTS AND/OR TOPICS COVERED:**
