1	Internship Program	WTAP offers an internship program to students at area colleges and universities.
		During this reporting year, the station hosted 2 interns. One from West Virginia University and one from Ohio University.
		These students were communications majors.
		They interned with our News Department and were supervised by the News Director.
2	Employee Training Programs	WTAP for years has a mentoring program that trains entry-level employees to advance into other positions.
		During this reporting year, several employees from our Creative Services department were cross-trained to expand their individual skill levels. Original job titles were photographer and editor. They were trained to become Creative Services Producers. This cross training was done by members of the department and the department director.
		In early 2018 we promoted a sales assistant to the position of Digital Marketing Coordinator. This employee participated in a number of training programs, including on-line and teleconference sessions with Local X our digital provider, Gray Digital-our corporate digital team and she traveled (Dec 3-15, 2017) out-of-state with our LSM to one of our other stations for several days of intensive digital training.

		During this reporting year, news employees traveled to outside training including our main anchor and a veteran reporter attending news workshops on March 24, 2018 at the West Virginia Broadcasters Association Excellence in Broadcasting Ceremony and training sessions.
3	Job Fairs	WTAP on-air staff as well as members of management respond to requests from secondary schools and colleges to lecture or speak on broadcasting, stressing the educational requirements necessary to work in the field. We also touch on other aspects of the station, i.e., accounting, traffic, sales, etc. During this reporting year, our News Director traveled to Job Fairs at Kent State University (10/19/2017) and West Virginia University
		Career Day (2/23/2018). At Kent State University there was a presentation to a group of students and following the meeting the News Director had individual meetings with 3 students. At the West Virginia University Career Day the News Director had 30-minute individual meetings with 10 students.
4	Scholarship Program	WTAP awards an annual scholarship, the Glenn Wilson Memorial Broadcast Scholarship to one area high school student who is planning to pursue a career in Broadcast Journalism. Funds for this scholarship are raised primarily through our annual (5/14/18) golf tournament. The program is administered through the Parkersburg Area Community Foundation as they administer a number of scholarships throughout the region. This year's scholarship was presented by one of our news staff and awarded on May 25, 2018 to a Parkersburg High School student.
