	Type Of Recruitment Initiative (Menu Selection)	Brief Description Of Activity
<b>1</b>	<i>(Internship Program]</i>	WTAP has established an internship program with Marietta College, West Virginia University at Parkersburg, Hocking College and Ohio University. Internships during this time period included: one student from Hocking College. He interned in the production department during the 2011 summer, 6/2011-8/2011. Also, a Marietta College student who earned her 3 credits for interning in the news department from May 11, 2011 through June 09, 2011.
<b>2</b>	Employee Training Programs	WTAP for years has a mentoring program that trains entry-level employees to advance into other positions. Although this program is primarily utilized in Production Control and News, it is flexible enough to be used in any department of the station.
<b>3</b>	Job Banks, Internet Programs and Other Outreach Programs	<p>WTAP on-air staff as well as members of management respond to requests from secondary schools and colleges to lecture or speak on broadcasting, stressing the educational requirements necessary to work in the field. We also touch on other aspects of the station, i.e., accounting, traffic, sales, etc. Events included the following:</p> <p>News Director John Fortney participated in a "Partners In Education" presentation to area high schoolers on March 21, 2012 at West Virginia University-Parkersburg.</p> <p>Weatherman Kirk Greenfield did a presentation on storms, in light of the recent sudden storm in</p>

		<p>the area, to the Ohio Valley Ski Club on March 5, 2012</p> <p>WTAP-TV Digital Media Specialist Les Patterson developed, implemented and oversaw a “Fan Club” to get viewers to donate new fans which the Salvation Army then gives through an application process to needy families. Fans were distributed on July 7th</p> <p>In addition, we routinely offer tours to groups from ages 8-9 on up including: Program Director Dirk Kreiss on April 27<sup>th</sup>, provided a tour, including observing a Noon Newscast, to 10 senior citizens as part of an outreach program with Lighthouse Baptist Church in Vincent, Ohio., Program Director, Dirk Kreiss, provided a tour on May 21<sup>st</sup> to 18 Greenmont Elementary Students who were specially selected to do daily school news reports. The tour included watching the WTAP News at Noon and a post-newscast Q&amp;A with our Noon News team.</p> <p>WTAP awards an annual scholarship, the Glenn Wilson Broadcast Memorial Scholarship to one area high school student. This year’s selectee is Matthew Dunbar from Fort Frye High School. Funds for this scholarship are raised through our annual golf tournament. The program is administered through the Parkersburg Area Community Foundation.</p>
