		During this reporting year, the station hosted 2 interns. One from West Virginia University and one from Ohio University.
		These students were communications majors.
		They interned with our News Department and were supervised by the News Director.
2	Training and Mentorship Program	WTAP has a mentoring program to train entry-level employees to advance into other positions.
		During this reporting year, a sales assistant was identified to participate in local and corporate training programs, including on-line and teleconference sessions with Local X our digital provider and Gray Digital (corporate digital team). She participated in on-site training at a sister station on November 10-11, 2017. As a result of her training, she was promoted in 2018.
		Three other employees from this station also participated in the corporate training
2	Job Fairs	During this reporting year, our News Director traveled to Job Fairs at Kent State University (Oct. 2017) and West Virginia University Career Day (March 2018).
		At Kent State University there was a presentation to a group of students and following the meeting the News Director had

		individual meetings with 3 students.  At the West Virginia University Career Day the News Director had 30-minute individual meetings with 10 students.
3	Scholarship Program	WTAP awards an annual scholarship, the Glenn Wilson Memorial Broadcast Scholarship to one area high school student who is planning to pursue a career in Broadcast Journalism. Funds for this scholarship are raised primarily through our annual (5/14/18) golf tournament. The program is administered through the Parkersburg Area Community Foundation as they administer a number of scholarships throughout the region. This year's scholarship was presented by one of our news staff and awarded on May 25, 2018 to a Parkersburg High School student.
